3.2. Practice Field and Competition Field

The practice field is organised on the field in the neighbourhood of the main competition field.

Competition field is field with natural grass. The official practice, qualifications and individual and team eliminations will be organised on this field. The distance between 2 shooting positions on the shooting line will be 1.05m. Mixed team gold

medal matches, team gold medal matches and individual gold medal matches will be organised on the final field, Orangery by main Lilleshall House. All medal matches will be shot alternate and will have live coverage. Videos will be published on World Archery YouTube.

Mixed team bronze medal matches and team bronze medal matches will be organised on the main field with simultaneous shooting.

3.3. Competition Program (published)

The latest competition program is published separately (lanseo). Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date-hour it was printed.

All competitors are split by the category – U21/U18

3.4 Practice and Warm up

Official Practice (3 hours) shooting AB-CD format:

- U18: 09:10 to 12:10
- U21: 14:30 to 17:30

Warm up will be organised on the competition field according to the schedule.

Practice field will be open Saturday (13th) from 14:00 until 17:00.

Sunday (14th) 10:00 – 13:00, then 14:00 - 17:00.

From Monday (15th) will open at 07:45 , will close for an hour between 12:00 - 13:00, then close one hour before end of competition schedule up until close on Friday (19th).

Non competing athletes will be allowed to practice only on the practice field until closure on Friday (19th).

There will be no practice available for non finals athletes on Saturday (20th).

Schedule may be modified if necessary.

3.5. Equipment Inspection

Equipment inspection will be held following the program of the official practice. Each team will be called (in the English alphabetical order) and invited by the announcer to the dedicated place for the equipment inspection on the competition field.

- There is no access to the competition field before or without accreditation is done.
- All team members (archers and officials) shall wear or bring their team uniforms.
- Spare equipment must also be brought to the equipment inspection.
- The start numbers will be given at the warm up on the day of the competition (it will be distributed on the shooting line, in front of archer's position).
- The target assignment will be published before the start of the official practice, so archers can practice on their assigned targets. The target assignment will be published only on boards and on internet.

3.6. Qualification Round & Information on scoring

30 seconds per arrow will be the time allowed for individual shooting during Qualification Round, therefore the time limit for 6 arrows will be 3 minutes. Although WA rules require compliance with this rule only for World Ranking Events, WA and WAE want competitions for youth to be organised at the highest level and give consistency for many of the young archers shooting senior events. The decision was made by the WAE Executive board.

Shooting in qualifications will be conducted with 3-4 archers per target in AB-CD format.

For the qualification rounds, no faces will be changed after the practice arrows. Please instruct the archers to mark the arrow holes during practice.

The athletes will have double scoring from qualification round till individual bronze medal matches and the same is for team and mixed team competition: one electronic and one on paper scorecard. For each target, one athlete will enter the score on the paper score sheet; another athlete will make the electronic scoring.

All the athletes on the same target must verify that the correct scores are entered.

Please instruct your athletes to fill in properly the scorecards including total score, 10's and X's and sign the card before handing them back after each round. Double scoring is required (one on paper and one electronic) and after the match also the winner has to be marked.

Examples of correctly populated score sheets are shown at the end of this document.

In case of tied score on positions 8 when we have more than 32 archers in the category, a shoot off will be arranged. Neutral targets will be used.

3.7. Individual Elimination Round

For the elimination rounds, no faces will be changed after the practice arrows. So please instruct the archers to mark the arrow holes during practice. Matches will start as soon as the field is ready. We will keep to the starting time at the beginning of the session and then the competition will run as it goes. Therefore some matches could start sooner than the time indicated in the schedule. Please be aware of this and be prepared for it.

Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, archers will be allowed to shoot, but no score will be recorded or allowed to be displayed.

The individual elimination round will with the 1/24 in categories where we have 33 – 56 archers. Top 8 individual archers will go directly to the 1/16 eliminations. Archers from 9th to the last position will shoot the 1/24 eliminations, as appropriate. Then the top 8 will join the winners of 1/24 eliminations to complete the 1/16 elimination.

Please check the schedule.

3.7.1 Recurve

The set system will be used for recurve division. All individual matches will consist of maximum 5 sets of 3 arrows per set. Archer with 6 set points wins the match.

3.7.2 Compound

The compound match round will be used for compound division. All matches will consist of 5 ends of 3 arrows, cumulative scoring.

3.8. Team and Mixed Teams Eliminations and Finals

The Team and Mixed team Elimination Round will start with the 1/12 or 1/8, depending on number of teams. Gold medal matches will be organized with alternating shooting and bronze simultaneous. Remember that you need an agent for the blind.

Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, teams will be allowed to shoot on the competition field, but no score will be recorded or allowed to be displayed.

Remember that the composition of the mixed team can be changed in writing at least 15 minutes before the start of official practice of that round of competition – see art. 4.3.2. below. The form is attached at the end of this document.

3.8.1. Recurve Team

- Max. 4 sets of 6 arrows, 2 arrows per archer (set points scoring). Team with 5 set points wins the match.

3.8.2. Recurve Mixed Team

- Max. 4 sets of 4 arrows, 2 arrows per archer (set points scoring). Team with 5 set points wins the match.

3.8.3. Compound Team

- 4 ends of 6 arrows, 2 arrows per archer (50m, cumulative scoring)

3.8.4. Compound Mixed Team

- 4 ends of 4 arrows, 2 arrows per archer (50m, cumulative scoring)

Shoot-off in Team eliminations and Finals with simultaneously shooting is just one arrow each archer, 60 sec per team (40 sec for Mixed Teams). In Bronze and Gold medal matches with alternating shooting the archers are alternating after every single arrow.

3.9. Individual Finals Round – Bronze and Gold Medal Matches

All Bronze and Gold medal matches individual, will have alternate shooting. The practice field for finalists will be organized close to the final field.

Remember that you need an agent for the blind.

3.10. Appeal Procedure (Form attached)

An Appeal form is attached to this document. In case of Intent to Appeal or an actual Appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form must be considered.

The Appeal form should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission or to his deputy. A fee of 50 EUR must be paid to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the Appeal to be valid.

If the Appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. In the case of the Appeal being rejected, the fee will not be returned.

4) Technical Matters (TD + chairman of Judges)

4.1. Timing Control system

The Danage timing equipment will be used for timing with several displays on the competition field. Chronotir system will be used on the practice field.

4.2. Results system

lanseo will be the system used for results. The scoring in the Qualification and Elimination Round will be done by the archers. One archer will write down the score on the paper score sheet and another archer will score on a tablet. The third/fourth archer verifies that the correct scores are entered.

The tablets are used during the Qualifications, Eliminations and Finals, but not during the Bronze and Gold medal matches alternating shooting.

4.3. Rules that apply in this event

4.3.1. Practice on the competition field during byes

Practice on the competition field during byes will be limited to three arrows per end and maximum of three sets for recurve and five ends for compound. If more than three arrows are shot by an athlete in an end after being warned by a judge, the athlete may be denied further practice on the competition field but any such violation shall not affect the next match.

4.3.2. Team members' nomination

A team shall consist of the highest ranked 3 (or 2 if a Mixed Team) athletes from the Qualification Round unless the Team Manager notifies the official approved result verifier or the Chairman of Judges in writing at least 15 minutes before the start of official practice of that round of competition of a substitution of another athlete who competed in the Qualification Round. In case of substitution medals will only be awarded to the athletes that the Team round, not the Qualification Round. A violation of the foregoing will result in disqualification of the team.

4.3.3. Number of team officials

A Team Manager may be helped by other team officials (such as coaches, physiotherapists, psychologists, etc.). There may not be more than one team official on the field of play for each athlete competing at the time. However, the maximum number of team officials on the field of play at the same time is four. This may be increased by one official per category if the Member Association has athletes competing in more than two categories at the same time.

4.3.4. Shoot-offs - Individuals:

- A single arrow shoot-off for score;
- If the score is the same the arrow closest to the centre of the target face shall resolve the tie and if the distance is the same, successive single arrow shoot-offs, until the tie is resolved.
- If both athletes miss the scoring area of the target, both athletes will shoot an additional arrow.

4.3.5. Equipment failure or medical issue (new art. 12.2.3):

- *In the event (during the qualification round) of an equipment failure, verified by a Judge, or a medical issue, verified by medical personnel, extra time may be given to make the necessary repairs, change the damaged equipment or for medical personnel to determine the problem and decide whether or not the athlete is fit to continue competing unassisted. However the maximum time or number of ends for make-up arrows to be shot is 15 minutes (following regular order of shooting and timing), or two ends of six arrows outdoors and three ends of three arrows indoors, whichever happens first. The athlete shall make up the appropriate number of arrows at the earliest opportunity under the supervision of a Judge.*

4.4. Rankings

After the end of this event, the Youth Cup Ranking will be prepared and the results obtained during the European Youth Championships in Lilleshall will be added to those one obtained in Bucharest.

The awarding of the Youth Cup circuit 2022 will take place immediately after the awarding of the competition.

4.5. Dress Instructions

Athletes, officials and staff should have a proper appearance when they are on the field during competition. Athletes, team officials and technicians should wear their national team uniforms (with same look per division following WA rules) and sport shoes.

Opened shoes are not allowed on the main competition field or the practice field.

We would like to remind all teams that names of archers and country code are appreciated for youth cup events, but mandatory only for archers participating in major events.

4.6. Lost arrows

All lost and find arrows are to be reported to judges. An arrow found on the field of play at later stage of the competition will be considered as a part of that end if not reported.

Lost arrows on the practice field must be reported to the event volunteers on that field.

5) Logistical Aspects (OC)

5.1. Transportation:

The transportation to the competition field (and practice field) will be for the morning and afternoon sessions plus a regular shuttle. Please remember all bows and arrows must go in coach hold, none will be allowed on the coach. The coach schedule is below –

6.2. Medal Ceremonies and Closing Ceremony

Medal ceremonies will be conducted as per the published schedule (lanseo)

After individual awarding the medallists will have to stay on the field for photographs. All teams are kindly asked to stay on the field till the end of the medal ceremony.

There will be short closing ceremony. The event will finish officially after the last medal ceremony at the finals venue.

8.1. Doping control

There will be doping control on this event.

9. Other matters of importance (WAE TD)

9.1. The environment

We ask you to instruct your athletes to use the litter bins which are placed behind the waiting area.

At the end of each session each country is asked to ensure their area is clear of everything ready for next session.

9.2. Water

The water on the field will be available via water dispensers, all athletes and officials will be issued with their own water bottle for use with these during the whole event.

9.3. Non smoking and no alcohol

This is a non smoking event for the practice and official competition areas. Inside sport area you are not allowed to smoke, you must use the designated areas outside the sport field (these will be signed). The location of the smoking area is the other side of the road from the trade stands and has white bollards around.

The same is valid also for electronic cigarettes. Smoking is not allowed within buildings in the UK.

Alcohol consumption is forbidden.

9.4. Lost items

All lost items will be taken to the Sport Info area (in the pavilion on the main field), so ask there if you lost something, or contact the Sport Info phone on WhatsApp.

An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, shall be expressed in writing and lodged with the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission within five minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever applies. During the Finals of match play rounds, the notice of intent to file an appeal shall be given within five minutes of the end of the match, or prior to the start of the next match, whichever is first.

Article 3.13.8:

Jury decisions shall be minuted and reported to the appellant, the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and the organisers before the beginning of the next stage of the competition or before the awarding of prizes.
