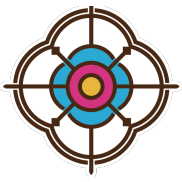

- 3.3. Official Practice (See schedule)
- 3.4. Equipment Inspection
 - During official practice on the 27 of September
 - Teams will be announced in alphabetical order by DOS
 - All teams are to wear their team uniform
 - Spare equipment must also be brought for inspection
 - Team managers are to check the personal details of their athletes (names, DOB, etc.).
 - Inform the Judge if details are not correct and the judge will inform Result Team
 - Athletes' numbers will be issued on the day of the Ranking round during practice
 - Athletes' numbers must be attached on the quiver, facing the waiting line while shooting.
- 3.5. Ranking Round and scoring information
 - U18 Recurve – 60m Round (72 arrows)
 - U18 Compound – 50m Round (72 arrows)
 - U21 Recurve – 70m Round (72 arrows)
 - U21 Compound – 50m Round (72 arrows)
- 3.6. Individual Elimination Round
 - Target faces will NOT be changed after practice arrows. Please instruct your archers to mark all the arrows holes during practice.
 - Matches will start as soon as the field is ready.
 - Matches at the start of each session will begin on time. Proceeding matches will follow up on the immediate completion of the prior match. Archers should be alert and prepared for their matches to start slightly earlier than scheduled.
 - Byes are permitted. If the competition schedule allows, no score will be recorded or displayed and the archers shooting as bye must respect the DOS timing and signals of the competition. During the competition for byes, individuals will be limited to first three sets for recurve and five ends for compound. No more than three arrows shall be shot for each end/set.
 - There will be no alternate shooting during the preliminary elimination rounds.



- 3.7. Recurve Elimination
- The set system will be used for all individual, Team and mixed team matches. Individual matches will consist of the best of 5 sets, (3 / 6 / 4 arrows per set) and the archer who will first reach a minimum of 6 (5 for Team) set points wins the match.
 - All matches, up to and including the bronze medal Match, will be shot simultaneously.
- 3.8. Compound Elimination
- Matches for all compound events will use cumulative scoring, consisting of 5 ends of 3/ 6 / 4 arrows per end. The archers /Team / Mixed Team with the highest cumulative score win the match.
 - All matches, up to and including the bronze medal Match, will be shot simultaneously on the qualification range for the individual events.
- 3.9. Team and Mixed Teams Elimination Round – (See document attached for schedule)
- All matches, up to and including the bronze medal Match, will be shot simultaneously.
 - Byes are permitted. If the competition schedule allows, no score will be recorded or displayed and the archers shooting as bye must respect the DOS timing and signals of the competition.
- 3.10. Recurve Team and Mixed Team – (See document attached for schedule)
- Team and mixed team will consist of the best 4 sets (6 arrows per team and 4 arrows per mixed team). The team that reaches a minimum of 5 set points first will win the match. All matches, up to and including the bronze medal Match, will be shot simultaneously on the qualification range for the individual, team and mixed team events.
- 3.11. Compound Team and Mixed Team – (See document attached for schedule)
- Matches for all compound events will use cumulative scoring, consisting of 4 ends of 4/6 arrows.
 - All matches, up to and including the Bronze Match, will be shot simultaneously on the qualification range for the team and mixed team events.
- 3.12. Individual Final Round and Team Final Round – (See document attached for schedule)
- Practice and Warm up field - Will have target in the same direction to the Fop Final.
 - Competing Archers can practice at the designated practice field before



their match.

- Alternate shooting at the FOP Final.
- 3.13. Appeal Procedure (Form attached)
- An Appeal form is attached to this document (See Attached)
 - In case of an Intent to Appeal or an actual Appeal, indicated time on the Appeal form must be considered.
 - Appeal Form should be given to the Chairperson of Tournament Judge Commission or to their deputy.
 - A fee of **US\$ 50** must be paid to the Chairperson of Tournament Judge Commission for the Appeal to be valid.
 - If the Appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. If the case of the Appeal begins rejected, the fee will not be returned.

4) Technical Matter (TD / CJ)

4.1. Timing Control system

- Timing equipment with Visual and Audio will be used

4.2. Result System

- Ranking Round – scoring will be done by archers. One archer record, on the official scorecard, the scores of all other archers on that target. At the same time, another archer on the same target will enter all the score of the archers on that target into the scoring tablet. The other archer should verify that all score is written and entered correctly.
- Scorecards **MUST** be signed by the archer and have the full total completed; in case of non-conformity, the archer will be Disqualified (DSQ).
- Scorecards with the 10's + X's and X count **NOT COMPLETED WILL BE COUNTED AND SCORED AS ZERO "0"**.
- Elimination Round – scoring will be done by archers. One archer/ Team records the arrows values of both archers/ team on the paper scorecard. While at the same time the other archer/team inputs the arrow values in the scoring tablet. **BOTH** archers/ teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning to the shooting line.
- At the end of the match, scorecard must be fully completed and signed by the archers involved in the match, otherwise the concerned archer(s) will be Disqualified (DSQ).
- Scoring tablet will be used during the Ranking and Elimination Rounds but



not in the Final. (WAA Results & Technology Team is responsible for the results of the event.)

4.3. Rules that apply in this event.

4.3.1 Shooting time

- The total time allowed to shoot an end shall be determined by the total number of arrows to shoot in an end, where:
- 20 seconds per arrow is the time allowed for individual alternate shooting, and for all team and mixed team rounds including shoot-offs.
- 30 seconds per arrow is the time allowed for individual shooting during qualifications, Olympic round and Compound rounds where alternate shooting does not apply, including shoot-offs.
- Qualification Round will be shot with sequence AB/CD

4.3.2 Qualification Round

- Equipment failure for medical problems, equipment and 3meter line situation is NOT ALLOWED but Make up arrows, 30s per arrow, for bouncer, pass through, Arrows remaining in target allowed.
- Archers Must stay in field after Qualification, in terms of possible bye, if not, Forfeit

4.3.3 Finals

- For FINALS, Undersleeves must be white or predominant color of shirt and for MIXED team, the uniform of COACH and archers must be the same.
- For finals coach must not come out of box and Archers can NOT bring bow up until the green signal is given and clock has started

4.4. Accreditation Cards Rules

- All archers and officials are issue with the Accreditation Card
- Accreditation cards must always be worn in the tournament field and during the Equipment inspection.

5) Logistical Aspects (OC)

- 5.1. Transportation – Airport to/from Official Hotels.
- 5.2. Meals – Practice / Qualification Round / Final. - Packed lunch at the tournament venue.
- 5.3. Hotel / Internet access. -Free access at official hotels

6) Protocol and Ceremonies (OC)

- 6.1. Medal Ceremonies
 - All archers involved in the ceremonies are requested to go to the



gathering point (Location will be confirmed during the event)

- All medal winners are requested to be at the gathering point of the Award Ceremony 15 mins before the ceremony is due to start.
- Medal ceremonies will be conducted immediately after the finals (Please Check the competition schedule)

8.1. Doping Control

- Anti-Doping control will follow WA and WAA rules.
- Archers should bring their passport and/or accreditation cards to the anti-doping control station if selected for the test.
