<b>Venue:</b>	Tolworth Court Sports Ground, Old Kingston Road, Tolworth KT4 7QH. Map: <a href="http://www.surreyarchery.org">www.surreyarchery.org</a>
<b>Rounds: (both stages)</b>	70m & Olympic rounds or 50m & Compound Match rounds both days <b>Only the Top 64 ranked archers per category go forward to the eliminations.</b>
<b>Faces</b>	Compound - 80cm 6 ring faces at 50m, Recurve - 122cm faces at 70m.
<b>Timings</b>	<i>Practice:</i> 2pm to 6pm Friday 12 <sup>th</sup> July (note that the gates are locked at 7pm & tents may be erected from noon) <i>Competition days:</i> Gates open at 7am. <i>Assembly</i> at 8.30 am followed by up to 45 minutes of practice.
<b>Categories</b>	Compound and Recurve – WA equipment rules apply. Longbow and Barebow will compete in the Recurve division. Juniors will compete as adults
<b>Awards</b>	Top three places for each Leg, Recurve Men, Recurve Women, Compound Men & Compound Women.
<b>Entry</b>	All entries via the <a href="#">Archery GB Membership Portal</a> Opens 28 <sup>th</sup> February 2019 at 7pm. Top 30 2018 ranked Archers 7 days prior. No refunds from 1 <sup>st</sup> July.
<b>Fees &amp; Cancellations</b>	£45 for the weekend. The entry fee less £5 will be refunded for cancellations before 1 <sup>st</sup> July. No refunds from this date. <b>Rules</b>	<a href="#">World Archery rules</a> apply. Music will be played during the event.
<b>Bosses</b>	TenZone layered foam bosses for all.
<b>Facilities</b>	Toilets provided (Inc. disabled) on the field & in the pavilion.
<b>Food</b>	Hot food and drinks available in the pavilion café from 7.30am.
<b>Parking and Travel</b>	Parking on hard standing and on grass behind tent line. Full access for disabled. 5-minute walk from buses and Tolworth Railway station.
<b>Camping</b>	Camping <a href="#">Horsley</a> or <a href="#">Walton</a> 20 minutes drive – There is no overnight camping on the University Sports Ground
