- Round:** Record Status and Arrowhead FITA 24 Target. Saturday unmarked, Sunday marked distances.
- Categories:** Freestyle, Compound Unlimited, Compound Limited, Compound Barebow, Longbow, Barebow, Traditional
DCAS and Exmouth Medals will be awarded in all classes on the following basis – 1st - 1 Archer, 2nd - 4 Archers, 3rd – 7 or more Archers.
- Shooting Pegs:** **Red:** All sighted classes except U15 sighted recurve (Freestyle)
Blue: Unsighted classes; U15 sighted recurve (Freestyle)
White: All Juniors under 12 and unsighted juniors up to the age of 15.
- Judges:** Pam Tonkin, assisted by Phil Gillbanks, Ann Gillbanks, Julia Hadley and Tara Earle
- Lady Paramount:** Pam Tonkin
- Entry Fee:** Adults - 2 Day £22.00. Single Day £11.00.
Juniors - 2 Day £18.00. Single Day £9.00.
Cheques payable to “Exmouth Archers” please.
Note that DCAS Juniors have free entry on Sunday courtesy of the DCAS Junior fund.

Entries will only be processed in order of receipt of payment. All refunds will be at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser, but none will be made after the closing date.
- Start Time:** Assembly will be in the car park area at 10:00. After which groups will be led to their start points on the course.
- Closing Date:** Monday 21st September.
- Refreshments:** Refreshments will be available throughout the day. **To try and be greener, we will not be using polystyrene cups. Please bring a suitable mug, lodge it with the catering team and we will fill it as you come in from shooting. Otherwise we will loan you a club mug..**
- Camping:** For those people wishing to shoot the both days camping will be available on our target ground if you are feeling brave!

- **Novices are welcome and encouraged to enter this event** and may shoot from the white peg at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser, however such archers will not be eligible for awards or claim records.
 - Only members of Archery GB and World Archery are permitted to shoot at this tournament.
 - **Membership Cards must be shown at Registration.**

- Use of **all** cameras **MUST** be registered in the registration book held by the tournament organisers.
- Target list will be available on the day.
- Practice targets will be available near the car park from 8:30
- **The Devon and Cornwall Championships will be held on the Sunday only**
- For those Juniors shooting, will parents/guardians please make sure that you complete the section on the entry form about drug testing and who you want the Junior(s) to shoot with.
- By entering this competition you agree that the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event, and at a schedule decided by the organisers. These include your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, email address, contact numbers, club, county, region and any Archery GB assigned codes for this information.
- **Drug Testing: Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; If they refuse that refusal will be treated as a positive result**

Directions: Take the A376 to Exmouth from the motorway (Junction 30). At the second roundabout (After M5 Junction) take the B3179, signposted Woodbury, Budleigh Salterton. Having passed through Woodbury take the next turning right, Signposted B3179, Exmouth, Budleigh Salterton. At the top of the hill turn right, Signposted B3179, Exmouth, Budleigh Salterton. Continue straight on towards Budleigh Salterton (B3179) Ignore all signposts to Exmouth. Parking will be in the small car park on the right opposite Wrights Lane. For reference our target grounds are another 400 yards further along the road on the left. PTO for map.
