World Record Status



Date & Timings: Saturday 19th September & Sunday 20th September 2020. Registration from 7:45 on arrival & Inspection from 08:00. Assembly (via PA) 09:00. 30 minutes of practice at 09:15.

Location: Woking Archery Club, Deers Farm Close, Wisley, Woking, Surrey GU23 6QX. [Find Woking AC](#)

Rounds: Double WA 70m, 60m & 50m Rounds each day shooting in 2 details. Archers will shoot either Saturday or Sunday. The results are generated by collating both days together. Archers may shoot both days only if space allows.

Judges Judges: Steve Vallis, Andrew Trimble, Netta Bridle & Helen Piper (Candidate).

Awards: Results will be posted online at ianseo.net every 3 dozen.

Fees: £20 per day. Because of the late opening for entries, there will be no refunds except for covid related reasons which will be less transaction and platform fees that the club cannot recover.

Bosses: Tenzone layered foam bosses.

Rules: WA Rules and Archery GB dress regulations, Rule 307, will apply.

Divisions & Compound classes - 50m, 6-zone 80cm face,

Classes: Recurve & Longbow - Senior 70m, Cadet 60m, 122cm face,
Barebow classes - 50m, 122cm face.

Food No food will be available at the event, please bring your own.
Hot and cold drinks will be available, please bring your own mug.

Facilities: Toilet block available: gents with a one in, one out basis; the Ladies can go in two at a time, one of the 3 cubicles will be closed. There will be sanitiser and wipes available

Smoking/Alcohol: Smoking/Vaping allowed behind the tents only. No alcohol is allowed on the field.

Liability: Woking AC will not be liable for damage to cars or other property at the event.

Dogs: Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times.

Covid-19 Precautions Please travel to the event alone. Spectators/coaches/drivers will not be allowed on the field of play (FoP) and must stay by the cars. This is to meet AGB/government guidelines for groups of people and social distancing on the FoP particularly.
Left handers will shoot to the left of their distance with a target gap on the left to avoid facing right handed Archers.

You should ask yourself the following questions before attending:

- Do you have a high temperature? Yes/No
- Do you have a new, continuous cough? Yes/No
- Do you have a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste? Yes/No
- Are you in a household or bubble with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past 14 days? Yes/No
- Are you in a lockdown area? Yes/No

If the answer to any of these is yes, then you should not attend the competition.

We will provide details about additional Covid related procedures along with the Target list, a few days before the competition. Unfortunately, lockdowns may also affect WAC, so be prepared just in case we have to cancel the Open at the last minute.
