

Return to Competition

PRACTICE STARTS AT 9:30

It is important that you read and understand the following information regarding what you should expect when you arrive at the competition and how the shooting will be organised during the day.

Please carefully consider and answer to yourself the following questions before you leave home for the competition on Sunday:

Do you have a high temperature?	Yes/No
Do you have a new, continuous cough?	Yes/No
Do you have a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste?	Yes/No
Are you in a household or bubble with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past 14 days	Yes/No
Are you in a lockdown area?	Yes/No*

^{*} If you are in an area of a local lockdown/restrictions, you must follow the guidance for your area as these may be slightly different.

If the answer to any of these is yes, then you should not attend the competition.

Travelling	 The competition is at Lilleshall National Sports Centre, TF10 9AT This event is limited to 60 people on the field, so please travel alone if you can Drivers, parents and guardians have to be outside of the fenced area, please do not gather, and please social distance
Arrival	 Please DO NOT arrive before 8:15am Tents can be put up after 8:15am A member of the work crew will meet you at the gates to the field for registration. You will be asked for an emergency contact at this point.
Parking	 See the attached map for parking information, you must not park anywhere else A parking marshal will direct you Please leave plenty of room between cars to allow for social distancing
Tent Areas	 There is adequate room behind the shooting line, but to ensure we can all socially distance we're asking you to pitch your tents along your 'target's lane edge facing into the lane, this gives a 4m wide circulation space and plenty of room to get to the waiting area. See the diagram below.
Equipment Inspection	 Judges will not touch any of your equipment Inspection will be visual; arrows must be marked as per the rules If bow scales are used for compounds they will be sanitised by the judges between each use and placed on a table

PPE & Sanitiser	 Please provide whatever PPE you feel comfortable with Bring your own hand sanitiser Hand sanitiser stations will be made available to everyone on the field and should be used when you enter and leave the field.
Food and Drink	 There will be no food or drink available to purchase onsite, please ensure you bring your own. PLEASE TAKE AWAY ALL YOUR RUBBISH
Toilets	 There will be 2 toilets next to the entrance gate to the field, one each for Male / Female, one of which will be a disabled access. There will be a sanitiser station near to the toilets Please wipe down all touch points with the wipes provided before and after use Pavilion toilets are not in use, any spectators must use toilets next to Lilleshall cafe



First Aid	 A nominated first aider will be present at the event to minimise contact and possible cross contamination we would advise participants to bring their own small first aid kit for minor incidents. All incidents must be reported to the organisers. 	
Shooting Procedure	 Please ensure social distancing at all times Please keep bows and scopes in the waiting area boxes in front of the tents when not in use First detail must remove scopes on the line after shooting, second detail 	
Scoring etc	can leave for next end. Archers on each target should decide who will perform the following roles at the target. Caller, Checker, Scorer, 2nd Scorer (duplicate scoring). Only the scorers should touch the scoreboards/sheets which you can collect at the target. When you get to the target you will find 2 spots on the ground, one for each archer. They are 2m apart so you can maintain social distancing with archers on your target and archers on the adjacent target. When score sheets need to be handed in, they should be signed, use your own pen please, and placed in a box near the DoS tent. We will be marking Arrow holes. Archers should only mark and pull their own arrows.	
Rubbish	Please take it home!
