1) Technical Aspects of the competition

1.1. Number of Participants per class

Number of Nations: 31
Updated April 5, 2021

Recurve Men Individual: 112
Recurve Women Individual: 89

1.2. Practice Field and Competition Field

The practice field is organized on the Konyaalti Stadium and it will be open between 04 April 2021 to 11 April 2021.

The Competition Field will be Antalya Archery Center and both fields are with natural grass. The official practice and all competitions including finals will be organized at the Antalya Archery Center.

During the finals on Sunday, warming up field will be organized at the Antalya Archery Center. All finals will have live coverage on the video screen and on internet.

1.3. Competition Program (attached)

The latest competition program is published. Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date-hour it was printed.

1.4. Practice and Warm Up

Official Practice (2,5 hours) shooting AB format:

Warm up during all days of the competition will be organized 30 minutes before the Competition on the Field of Play except for:

- During the finals the competing athletes will have the warmup organized next to the final field. Noncompeting archers will be allowed to use the Practice field till Sunday afternoon. All prescribed epidemiological measures must be strictly observed. The schedule will be published.

1.5. Equipment Inspection

Equipment inspection will be held following the program of the official practice. Each team will be called (in the English alphabetical order) and invited by the announcer to the dedicated place for the Equipment inspection on the competition field. Also, all spare equipment must be brought to the equipment inspection.

All team members (archers and officials) should wear their team uniforms and accreditation card.

The correct spelling of athlete's names, as well as the correct date of birth in the archers' list will be checked during the accreditation.

The start numbers will be given at the warmup on the day of the competition (it will be distributed on the shooting line, in front of each archer's position). When receiving the registration numbers, we would like each Team Manager to double check that each archer has the correct "athlete number".

There are some late arrivals of teams; however, we will try to publish the start list before the start of the Official practice, so archers can practice on their assigned targets.

There is no access to the Competition field for the Official practice before the accreditation is done.

1.6. Qualification Round & Information on Scoring

Target assignments will be published only on boards and on internet.

Shooting in qualifications will be conducted with 2 archers per target in AB format.

For the qualification rounds, no faces will be changed after the practice arrows. Please instruct the archers to mark their arrow holes during practice.

The athletes will have double scoring from qualification round till individual bronze medal matches: one electronic and one on paper scorecard. For each target, one athlete will enter the score on the paper score sheet; another athlete will make the electronic scoring. For the electronic scoring the wireless equipment will be used. Archers can train to use it during the official practice. All the athletes on the same target must verify that the correct scores are entered.

Please instruct your athletes to fill in properly the scorecards including total score, 10's and X's and sign the score card before handing them back after each round.

In case of tied score on positions 8 when we have more than 32 archers in the category, a shoot-of will be arranged (1 arrow closest to the centre). Neutral targets will be used.

1.7. Individual Elimination Round

For the elimination rounds, no faces will be changed after the practice arrows. So please instruct the archers to mark the arrow holes during practice. Matches will start as soon as the field is ready.

We will keep to the starting time at the beginning of the session and then the competition will run as it goes. Therefore, some matches could start sooner than the time indicated in the schedule. Please be aware of this and be prepared for it.

Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, archers will be allowed to shoot, but no scores will be recorded or allowed to be displayed.

The individual Elimination Round will start with the 1/48 in categories where we have 56 or more archers and with 1/24 in categories where we have 33 – 55 archers. Top 8 individual archers will go directly to the 1/16 finals. Archers from 9 to the last position will shoot the 1/24 eliminations, as appropriate. Then the top 8 will join the winners of 1/24 eliminations to complete the 1/16 elimination.

Please carefully check the schedule.

1.7.1. Recurve

The Set System will be used for Recurve division. All individual matches will consist of maximum 5 sets of 3 arrows per set. Archer with 6 set points wins the match.

1.7.2. Compound

The Compound Match Round will be used for Compound division. All matches will consist of 5 ends of 3 arrows, cumulative scoring.

1.8. Individual Finals Round - Bronze and Gold Medal Matches

All Bronze and Gold medal matches individual will have alternate shooting. The field will be divided in two areas – the final field and the practice field for finalists.

Remember that you will need an agent for the blind.

Due to epidemiological recommendations, we are not expecting that all participants of this event will be present during finals. Spectators will not be allowed to follow finals at the field.

1.9. Appeal Procedure (Form attached)

An Appeal form is attached to this document (see attached after this chapter, Appendix 1) In case of Intent to Appeal or an actual Appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form must be considered.

The Appeal form should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission or to his deputy. A fee of 50 € must be paid to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the Appeal to be valid.

If the Appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. In the case of the Appeal being rejected, the fee will not be returned.

2) Technical Matters

2.1. Timing Control System

The TAF Timing equipment will be used for timing with several displays on the competition and practice field will be used.

2.2. Results System

IANSEO is the provider of the results. The scoring in the Qualification and Elimination Round will be done by the archers. One archer will write down the score on the paper score sheet and another archer will score on a terminal.

The terminals are used during the Qualifications, Eliminations and Finals, but not during the Gold and Bronze medal matches on Finals day.

2.3. Rules that apply in this event

2.3.1. Practice on the competition field during byes

Practice on the competition field during byes will be limited to three arrows per end and maximum of three sets for recurve and five ends for compound. If more than three arrows are shot by an athlete in an end after being warned by a judge, the athlete may be denied further practice on the competition field, but any such violation shall not affect the next match.

2.4. Dress Instructions

Athletes, officials, and staff should have a proper appearance when they are on the field during competition. Athletes, team officials and technicians should wear their national team uniforms (with same look per division following WA rules) and sport shoes.

Opened shoes are not allowed on the field of play.

We would like to remind all teams that names of archer and country code are appreciated for this event, but mandatory for archers participating in major events.

2.5. Lost Arrows

All lost and find arrows are to be reported to judges.

3) Logistical Aspects

3.1. Transportation

A daily shuttle service will be available from the official hotels to competition venue / practice venue free of charge. Please be aware that archers with the bow, the part of the

bow or with arrows in the hand will not be allowed to enter the bus for safety reasons. All such equipment should be placed in the bow case or bag.

3.2. Meals

Due to epidemiological recommendations, all meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) will be served at the hotels according to the schedule announced in the hotel.

3.3. Accreditation Cards Rules

The accreditation card must be always worn in the practice and competition areas. Only archers and their officials who are shooting at that moment can be on the field of play. Archers acting as coach in finals may ask for the new accreditation card.

4) Protocol and Ceremonies

4.1. Opening

Due to epidemiological recommendations here will be no Opening Ceremony organized.

4.2. Medal Ceremonies and Closing Ceremony

Due to epidemiological recommendations Medal ceremonies will be different from the previous ones. For individuals the medal ceremony will be organized on Sunday, after finals. The awarding of EGP 2021 will be organized simultaneously.

All archers involved in the ceremonies are requested to go to the gathering point ASAP to proceed quickly and smoothly with the simplified award ceremony.

After awarding the medalists will have to stay on the field for the picture, respecting the 2 m distance.

Due to epidemiological recommendations, there will be no closing ceremony. The event will finish officially after the last medal ceremony at the finals venue.

5) Medical Related issues (Medical Representative)

There is a person responsible for the First Aid on the field and the doctor and First Aid Service are nearby. In emergency the ambulance also will be ready on side.

In case of emergency during your stay in the hotel, please inform the reception and proper arrangements will be made.

5.1. PCR Tests

All the participants who needs the PCR test for to return back their Countries will be able to have test before leaving the Turkey. The teams has to fill PCR Application Form during the accreditation and has to return forms before 08 April 2021 to accreditation office. The

PCR Tests will take place at the hotel and all the teams will have separated time slots for to get in the test. LOC will check the time limits (72 hours or 48 hours) for each country and will arrange the test reservations according the these limits. Tests will take place at Saturday and Sunday and the cost will be 50,00€ per person. Test results will be printed and delivered to Team Manager before leaving from hotel for to departure.

6) Doping Control

6.1. Doping Control

There will be random doping control on this event.

6.2. Alcohol Test

Level of alcohol will be tested during the Doping Control.

7) Other matters of importance

7.1. The environment

We ask you to instruct your athletes to use the litter bins which are placed behind the waiting area.

7.2. Water

Bottled water will be available at the venue.

7.3. Nonsmoking and nonalcoholic

This is a nonsmoking event for the practice and official competition areas. Inside sport area you are not allowed to smoke, you must use the designated areas outside the sport field. The same is valid also for electronic cigarettes.

Alcohol consumption is forbidden.

7.4. Lost Items

All lost items will be brought to the DoS stand, so ask there if you lost something.

7.5. Weather

Temperatures in April are expected to range between 20 and 25 degrees Celsius. The average in the last few years has been 23 degrees Celsius.

Article 3.13. WA Rules book

An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, must be expressed in writing and lodged with the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission within 5 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first. During the Finals of match play rounds, the notice of intent to file an appeal shall be given within five minutes of the end of the match, or prior to the start of the next match, whichever is first.

The **written appeal** shall be lodged with the Jury within 15 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first.
