AWARDS

Trophies/medals will be awarded following the Sunday Clout and will be based on the aggregate scores of both days & depending on the number of archers in each category. Novice archers may choose to shoot a shorter distance but will not be eligible for awards.

SHOOTING RULES & DRUG TESTING

This tournament will be shot to Archery GB Rules in force at the time of the event. Archers competing at record status events may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply - non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents/guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form giving consent for the junior archer (under 18 years) to be tested if approached.

SMOKING

Please note that smoking (including vaping & e-cigarettes) is only permitted behind the tents. Please DO NOT leave any cigarette butts on the ground. Entry to this event is considered as acceptance of this policy.

A selection of hot & cold food and drinks will be available throughout the weekend.
