We have decided to revert to having an assembly and starting at 10am, where we will lead groups onto the course. Parking will be along the roads surrounding our grounds. The layby by the gate, Wrights Lane opposite and the one way bit of St Johns Road just beyond the gate. The car park will be reserved for Judges and work party only.

Steve will be doing his usual catering in the car park and the course has been re-designed with 3 loops of 8 targets so plenty of opportunities to buy. We ask please, so that we can minimise waste, that you bring your own mug for Tea/Coffee.

And just a note about Covid. Whilst restrictions have lifted, we mustn't forget that this pandemic is far from over. We therefore remind you that whilst you may be comfortable with less social distancing or not wearing masks, there may be others around you that are still being cautious. Please respect their wishes and if you are asked to adapt your behaviour when behind the peg or when up at the target scoring with your target companions then please do so without fuss or question. We ask please, that you take all your rubbish home.

Scoring will be with one card scoresheet and the second method will be using Ianseo on our PDAs. However it is the Archers responsibility to ensure that the totals tally on both scoring methods and that arrow values are recorded correctly. Archers should sign their scorecards at the end with their own pen and we recommend that Archers pull their own arrows.
