Arrows will be shot in ends of 6 throughout the day. Recurves and Compounds will shoot on a 4 face arrangement, Longbow and Barebow on a single face at 50m and 30m. All bowstyles will shoot on Tenzone layered foam targets. PDAs and lanseo will be used for scoring.

Catering:

There will be no refreshments available during the day. Team Managers may organise refreshments themselves. Bacon Butties will be available to purchase for £2.50by all. It will be up to team managers whether your county pays and this may only be by pre-arrangement. Tea and a professionally made cake will be provided for all teams plus up to six others in each County prior to the presentation of the Awards from the Exmouth Archers Indoor Centre. With any luck, we may also get a visit from the ice cream van!

Dress:

Archers are asked to respect the status of this tournament and requested to wear County Colours. If this is not possible dark green and/or white would be preferred.

Trophies:

Will Trophy holders please remember to return them on the day in a clean condition. Trophy winners were notified to your team managers in the invitation to submit a team some weeks ago. It will be the responsibility of the Team Manager to ensure that their Archers are reminded.

Presentation:

Presentation will take place at the end of shooting and will be held outside the Indoor Centre. If it is wet, then we will go indoors. We ask please that you bring a face mask should that be the case.

Drug Testing:

Record Status tournaments are liable for drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply. A refusal is treated as a positive result. Juniors must have written parental consent.

Notes:

Due to the lack of space behind the tent line we ask that archers be considerate when setting up their tents. Please do not obstruct the marked footways in any way, and share tents if at all possible (Covid19 permitting)

The current format is with no scores will be dropped and the leaderboard will reflect the actual team positions.

Scores will only be dropped if there is an issue on the day. Not if a County cannot field a full team

DWAA:

Due to the situation in Dorset and Wilts, they will not be submitting a team this year. The GWAS council has agreed that the DWAA spaces may be sold to any member of GWAS and as you will see from the target list there are several Archers who have taken up this offer. If you know of someone who would like to shoot, then please let me know. A reminder to the Archers in DWAA spaces. You will not be eligible for any awards and you are shooting for your own score. Your £15 entry fee, will however entitle you to tea and cake at the end of the day, and as noted above Bacon Butties will be for sale at the beginning of the day,

Covid-19:

Whilst restrictions have lifted, we mustn't forget that this pandemic is far from over. We therefore remind you that whilst you may be comfortable with less social distancing or not wearing masks, there may be others on the field that are still being cautious. Please respect their wishes and if you are asked to adapt your behaviour when behind the line or when up at the target scoring with your target companions then please do so without fuss or question. Likewise, if you wish to be cautious, then do not be afraid to say something to others.

Importantly, these rules still apply...

Before you consider traveling to the shoot we ask that you ask yourselves the following questions

- Do you have a high temperature?
- Do you have a new, continuous cough?
- Do you have a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste?
- Are you in a household or bubble with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past days?

If the answer to any of these are yes, then stay at home.

For this event target spacing will return to almost normal with 3m lanes. This does not allow the wide walkways and tent spacing as we had with the previous guidance. The scoring marks and equipment boxes will also not be marked. Please erect your tent avoiding the marked walkways, considering other archers around you.

Please bring whatever PPE you feel comfortable with, including hand sanitiser and wipes.

Toilets will be available in the Football changing rooms and Exmouth Archers Clubhouse and have hot running water and hand soap available but we recommend that you bring wipes and sanitiser to protect yourself throughout the day. Note, there will not be any event toilets on the field itself. Breaks will be longer to cater for this.

We ask please, that you take all your rubbish home.

We recommend that ONE person does the scoring on your target, however target companions MUST watch that all arrow values are being recorded correctly on the scoresheet. Archers should sign their scoresheets at the end with their own pen and we recommend that Archers pull their own arrows.
