

British Target Championships 2021

It is important that you read and understand the following information regarding what you should expect when you arrive at the competition and how the shooting will be organised during the day.

Please ask yourself the following questions before you leave home for the competition:

Do you have a high temperature?	Yes/No
Do you have a new, continuous cough?	Yes/No
Do you have a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste?	Yes/No
Are you in a household or bubble with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past 14 days	Yes/No
Have you been informed to self-isolate via the NHS app.	Yes/No

If the answer to any of these is yes, then you should not attend the competition.

We kindly request that people attending this event take a lateral flow test within 24 hours of attendance of this event.

Travelling	 The competition is at Lilleshall National Sports Centre, TF10 9AT. Drivers, parents, guardians & coaches have to stay behind the RED line. Please try not gather in large groups Athletes who require assistance are asked to inform the TO in advance who will be assisting them on the day.
Arrival	 Please DO NOT arrive before 7:30 am Tents cannot be put up until 6pm on 6 August Registration will take place during equipment inspection
Parking	 See the attached map for parking information, a parking marshal will direct you to the correct location. Please leave plenty of room between cars to allow for social distancing.
Equipment Inspection	 Judges should not touch your equipment, although if they do need to (i.e. checking binoculars) then they will sanitise before and after. Inspection will be visual and your equipment must confirm with the rules of shooting as normal for the event. Where bowscales are used they will be sanitised before and after use. Equipment inspection from – 8:15am
PPE & Sanitiser	 Please provide whatever PPE you feel comfortable with. Bring your own hand sanitiser. Hand sanitiser stations will be made available to everyone on the field and should be used when you enter and leave the field.
Food and Drink	The Pavilion Café is open. Each day serving hot and cold food.
Toilets	 There will be 3 toilets in the pavilion, one each for Male / Female, and one which will be a disabled access, as well as 2 porta-loos on the field. There will be sanitiser stations near to the toilets. Please wipe down all touch points with the wipes provided before and after use.
First Aid	A nominated first aider will be present at the event. To minimise contact and possible cross contamination we would advise participants to bring their own small first aid kit for minor incidents. All incidents must be reported to the organisers.



Shooting Procedure	 Please ensure social distancing at all times. Please keep shooting equipment in the waiting area in front of the tents when not in use. Scopes may be left on the line
Scoring etc	 On each target one archer will complete the paper scorecards and one the electronic tablet. These roles should <u>not</u> be swapped through the day. Please maintain social distancing at the target & with archers on the adjacent target.
	 When score sheets need to be handed in, they should be signed, using your own pen please, and placed in a box near the DoS tent.
	We will be marking arrow holes at all times, even practice
	Archers should only mark and pull their own arrows.
	 Please ensure that score and totals for 10's & X's are included before signing and handing in.

Official info for Spectators

Spectators are permitted to attend, but must not gather in groups

The Lilleshall main café is open again, and the café on the field.

Please note spectators are allowed in front of the tents, please stay in the area of your tent.

Anyone who does wish to stay and watch can observe from behind the RED spectator line on the field.

- Please do not cross this line, and you must socially distance with other spectators.
- Line tents must be behind the tent line
- Spectators are permitted to use the pavilion toilets only.
