Rules

- 1. Tournament will run over two consecutive Saturdays:
 - 27th November 2021 Ranking round
 - 04th December 2021 Finals
- 2. Ranking round will consist of a single Bray I round.
- 3. Finals will consist of head to head set matches:
 - Non compound, first archer to 6 set points wins.
 - Compound, highest combined score wins.
- 4. Ranking round and finals will be shot on either the ten ring single-spot face, (non compound bows), or the five ring three-spot face, (compound bows).
- 5. Scoring is the indoor metric scoring system. X, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, M Compound archers 10's are only the small inner, inner 10.
- 6. Sessions and target assignments will be available at the Friday 26th November 2021 club day, and will be emailed to all entrants. Entrants will also be able to collect accreditation badges.
- 7. All scores must be witnessed by another archer/scorer.
- 8. All arrow values must be recorded on an official tournament score sheet.
- 9. Details of tournament results, including score sheets will available at following Wednesday & Friday club days, on the tournament webpage and on the I@nseo website.
- 10. Details of the head to head matches will be available on the following Wednesday & Friday club days.
- 11. All rounds are shot under club day rules.
- 12. Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd places and a trophy awarded to the 1st placed archer.
- 13. Best gold of the tournament and worst white prices will be awarded during the ranking round.
- 14. Entrants, are solely responsible for the safety at the location used for this competition.
- 15. Tournament Organisers decision shall be final in all matters.
- 16. By submitting an entry to this tournament, you are accepting the rules and conditions.

Ranking Round — 27th November 2021

The ranking round ranks archers based on the total scored 1^{st} to total entries, in the two categories for the tournament, (compound & non compound). These rankings are then used to compile the head to head matches for the 4^{th} of December finals.

- Archers will be assigned a target and start time, please insure your arrive with good time to set up and be ready for your sighters.
- A single Bray I round. (Thirty [30] arrows at 20 yards on a 40cm target face).
- Archers will shoot ends of three arrows.
- Archers should leave in there best golds and worst whites and call the tournament organiser for an assessment.
- All score sheets must be fully completed, (all boxes!), signed by both archer and scorer and then returned to the tournament organiser at the end of the round.

Finals — 4th December 2021

- Archers will be assigned a target and start time, please insure your arrive with good time to set up and be ready for your sighters.
- Head to head matches will consist of five sets of three (3) arrows.
- A single arrow shoot off will be shot in the event of a draw.
- Non compound matches:
 - The first archer to 6 set points wins the match and progresses to the next match. The loosing archer is nocked out of the tournament.

- Compound matches:
 - The archer with the highest accumulative score of the five sets wins the match and progresses to the next match.
- All score sheets of the loosing archer must be fully completed, (all boxes!), signed by both archers and returned to the tournament organiser at the end of each match.
- Presentation of all awards will take place after the finals have been shot.
