WINTER FROSTBITE LEAGUE 2021/22

Rules

1. Tournament will run from October 1st 2021 to 28th February 2022 inclusive. (Five rounds)
2. Single category for each bow styles.
3. Archers will shoot on the ten ring single-spot face.
4. Archers will shoot thirty six (36) arrows from thirty metres.
5. Scoring is the indoor metric scoring system. X,10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, M Compound archers 10 are only the small inner, inner 10.
6. Archers may shoot as many rounds as they like during each month of the tournament and submit their best score only. (Complete rounds *must* be shot in one session).
7. Archers may enter multiple times with different bow styles, (in which case five rounds must be submitted for *each* bow style), for a single entry fee but please submit two entry forms one with each bow style.
8. Archers may use scores they they have used for other tournament, (there is no requirement to shoot a round specificity for this tournament).
9. Archers will shoot ends of either three arrows or six arrows.
10. All scores must be witnessed by another archer/scorer.
11. Phone apps maybe used to record and submit results.

12. Competed score sheets can be submitted via email, (tournaments@asgardarchery.com) or via the I@nseo³ ScoreKeeper App, (please indicate on the application you wish to use ScoreKeeper App, this is so that you can be sent your monthly QRcodes to scan into the app).
13. Blank score sheets, if required are available on the tournament webpage, the I@nseo website or by request via email.
14. Score sheets must be submitted by 19:00 on the last day of the month, no exceptions.
15. Details of tournament results, including score sheets will be on the tournament webpage and on the I@nseo website, which will be updated as results are received.
16. Main Tournament will be decided by highest combined score, ties to be determined by most 10's or X's dependant on bow style and then hits.
