World Record Status



Date & Timings: Sunday 12th June 2022. Registration & Inspection from 08:45. Assembly 09:45 followed by 30 minutes of practice.

Archers can also enter to shoot on Senior targets at the Surrey Junior Archery Championships on Sat 11th June (This is a stand alone competition, results will not be combined with Sunday).

Rounds: Double WA 70/60m & 50m rounds each day shooting in 2 details.

Judges: Judges: Andrew Trimble, Graham Potts & Helen Piper (Candidate)

Entry & Fees: Entry is via the AGB Portal, agb.sport80.com, fee is £22 per day. Any refunds for cancellations are made less transaction fees which the club cannot recover. There will be no refunds after Sunday 1st June.

Entries for the Senior targets on the Junior Day (Saturday) can also be made via the AGB portal. Goto the Surrey Junior Open Championships and Select "Senior (Separate Adult Competition)" in the age group options.

Bosses: Tenzone layered foam bosses.

Rules: WA Rules and Archery GB dress regulations will apply.
Music may be played during the event.

Awards: Awards for Men & Women in the Recurve, Compound, Barebow, and Longbow disciplines and in all WA recognised Age groups (depending on entry).

Divisions: Recurve & Longbow - 70m & 60m for Under 18s (122cm face).
Compound - 50m, (individual 6-zone 80cm face).
Barebow - 50m, (122cm face).

Classes: 50+, Senior, U21 & U18. Men and Women.

Food Food and drinks will be available for breakfast (bacon/sausages & vegetarian options etc.). There will be a barbecue at lunchtime.
Hot and cold drinks will be available. If you can please bring your own mug.

Facilities: Ladies and gents toilet block on the field. There will be sanitiser and wipes available.

Smoking/Alcohol: Smoking/Vaping allowed behind the tents only. No alcohol is allowed on the field.

Liability: Woking AC will not be liable for damage to cars or other property at the event.

Dogs: Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times.

Covid-19 Precautions Woking Archery Club will apply all relevant covid regulations in force at the time of the shoot
Details of Covid related procedures will be provided along with the Target list, a few days before the competition.
