Note – Some target allocations will change for the Nationals on Friday just to mix you up a bit so you can make new friends. However, I won't be moving you far from your tent! These changes will be published during the first two days.

Whilst restrictions have lifted and things have significantly improved, Covid-19 is still about. We therefore remind you that whilst you may be comfortable with no social distancing or not wearing masks, there may be others on the field that are still being cautious. Please respect their wishes and if you are asked to adapt your behaviour when behind the line or when up at the target scoring with your target companions then please do so without fuss or question. Likewise, if **you** wish to be cautious, then **do not** be afraid to say something to others.

Importantly, these rules still apply...

Before you consider traveling to the shoot we ask that you ask yourselves the following questions

- Do you have a high temperature?
- Do you have a new, continuous cough?
- Do you have a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste?
- Are you in a household with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past days?

If the answer to any of these are **yes, then stay at home.**

We would recommend a lateral flow test to be sure. Please bring whatever PPE you feel comfortable with, including hand sanitiser and wipes.

For this event target spacing will return to the normal lane width. This does not allow the wide walkways and tent spacing as we had with the previous guidance. Please erect your tent avoiding the marked walkways, considering other archers around you and how they may get to the shooting line. We ask that line tents must not be erected until the work party have completed setup of the field.

Parking will be in the "Camping" field at the end of the drive, with disability parking in the small car parks on the right as you drive down the drive. See plan below. Please observe any directions given by the work party.

Toilets will be available in the pavilion.

We ask please, that you take all your rubbish home.

Tea, Coffee and Biscuits will be available for Archers during the morning and afternoon breaks. Please bring your own mug if you wish to partake.

A nominated first aider will be present at the event, however, we would advise participants to bring their own small first aid kit for minor incidents. All incidents must be reported to the organisers.
