Events:	The weekend is being sold as separate days but you can enter both days. Saturday 9th July is a Tier 2+ Double WA 70/60/50m round. Sunday 10th July is the National Tour Stage 5 , a WA 70/50m ranking round with Olympic, Compound and Barebow match play. 6 arrows will be shot in 3 minutes on both days
Entry	All entries via the <u>Archery GB Membership Portal</u> Public Entry opens Thursday 24 th March 2022 at 7pm.
Fees & Cancellations	£25 per day or £45 for 2 days. The entry fee less £5 will be refunded for cancellations before 12 th June. No refunds from this date. To withdraw, please e-mail the event organisers (saw@surreyarchery.org).
Categories	Recurve, Compound and Barebow on both days. Under 21 & Under 18 Archers shoot as Seniors (excepting those Under 18's electing to shoot the 60m Recurve round on Saturday). Longbow Archers shoot as Recurve.
Awards	Top three places for Recurve, Compound, and Barebow, Men & Women on both days.
Timings	<i>Practice:</i> 2pm to 6pm Friday 8 th July (note that tents may be erected from noon & the gates are locked at 7pm) <i>Competition days:</i> gates open at 7am. <i>Assembly</i> at 8.30 am followed by 2 ends of practice.

Faces	Compound - 80cm 6 ring faces at 50m, Recurve - 122cm faces at 70/60m, Barebow – 122cm at 50m

Rules	World Archery rules and Archery GB dress regulations, Rule 307, will apply. 6 arrows will be shot in 3 minutes throughout the weekend. Music may be played throughout the event.
Bosses	TenZone layered foam bosses.
Facilities	Toilets provided (inc. disabled) on the field & in the pavilion.
Food	Unfortunately, the organisers have been unable to arrange for catering to be available on site.

Parking and Travel	Parking on hard standing and on grass behind tent line. Full access for disabled. 5-minute walk from buses and Tolworth Railway station.	
Camping	Camping <u>Horsley</u> or <u>Walton</u> 20 minutes drive – There is no overnight camping on the Tolworth Court Sports Ground.	
Hotels	Premier Inn, Tolworth (closest) / Premier Inn Epsom North / Premier Inn Chessington / Warwick Lodge / Travelodge Chessington Tolworth.	
Dogs	No dogs, other than working assistive dogs, are allowed on site	
Drugs etc	No smoking/vaping or alcohol is allowed on the field of play or in the tent area.
