Round: WA50 (Barebow): Barebow & American Flatbow

Six dozen arrows at 50 meters on a 122cm target face, WA Outdoor scoring

WA50 (Compound): Compound

Six dozen arrows at 50 meters on a 80cm target face, WA Outdoor scoring

WA70: Recurve & Longbow

Six dozen arrows at 70 meters on a 122cm target face, WA Outdoor scoring

Format: Individual tournament: Highest combined score from all six rounds.

Team tournament: Highest combined handicapped score of all team members, from all six rounds.

Ties will be determined by most number of X's and then hits.

Compete rounds must be shot in one session.

The first round shot at any time during each month of the tournament must be submitted. Multiple

rounds to better the score may **NOT** be shot.

Venue: At your club, shop or private range with insurance

Shooting Procedure: Ends of six arrow will be shot in four minutes.

Awards: Medal will be awarded in all classes based on the following entries:

1 archer: gold only 4 archers: gold and silver

7+ archers: gold, silver and bronze

A single prize will be awarded to the tournaments highest individual Junior score.

A single prize will be awarded to the tournaments highest individual Ladies score.

A single prize will be awarded to the tournaments highest individual Gentlemen's score.
