Rules

- 1. Tournament will run from 1st March 2022 to 31st August 2022 inclusive, (six rounds, 1 per month).
- 2. Archers will shoot the following rounds:-
 - Barebow/AFB WA50M (Barebow), six dozen arrows at 50m on a 122cm face
 - **Compound** WA50M (Compound), six dozen arrows at 50m on a 80cm face. Either 5 or 10 ring faces.
 - Longbow/Recurve WA70M, six dozen arrows at 70m on a 122cm face
- 3. Scoring is the world archery outdoor metric X ring scoring system. (X, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, M)
- 4. Archers will shoot ends of six arrows.
- 5. Complete rounds *must* be shot in one session.
- 6. The first round shot at any time during each month of the tournament must be submitted. This may be a round shot for/at another tournament and does not need to be a round shot specifically for this tournament, as long as it's the first round of the month this requirement has been met.
- 7. Multiple rounds to better the score may **NOT** be shot.
- 8. In the event of holiday/illness/bad weather, archers will be able to shoot a maximum of two 'catch-up' rounds, having first informed the tournament organiser. This must be shot in the month following¹.
- 9. All scores must be witnessed by another archer/scorer.
- 10. Archers must submit one fully completed score sheet for each month of the tournament.
- 11. Classes for senior and junior archers, junior archers may shoot up, senior archers may not shoot down.
- 12. Phone apps maybe used to record and submit results. (For example Android: MyTargets², iPhone: Archery Scoresheets³)
- 13. Competed score sheets can be submitted via email, (tournaments@asgardarchery.com) or via the I@nseo⁴ ScoreKeeper App, (please indicate on the application you wish to use ScoreKeeper App, this is so that you can be sent your monthly QRCodes to scan into the app).

- 14. Blank score sheets, if required are available on the tournament webpage, the I@nseo website or by request via email.
- 15. Score sheets must be submitted by 19:00 on the last day of each month, no exceptions.
- 16. Details of tournament results, including score sheets will be on the tournament webpage and on the I@nseo website, which will be updated as results are received.
- 17. Teams of three (3) archers must be named on the entry form. The team is fixed for the entire tournament.
- 18. Team members will also be entered into the individual tournament.
- 19. Archers may shoot as individuals and/or as a member of a maximum of one (1) team.
- 20. Archers may enter multiple times with different bow styles, (in which case six rounds must be submitted for *each* bow style), for a single entry fee but please submit two entry forms one with each bow style.
- 21. Individual Tournament: will be decided by highest combined score from all six rounds, ties to be determined by most number of X's and then hits.
- 22. Team Tournament: will be decided by highest combined handicapped score of the team of archers from all six rounds, ties to be determined by most X's and then hits.
- 23. Medal will be awarded in all classes based on the following entries;

1. 1 archer/team: gold only
 2. 4 archers/teams: gold and silver

3. 7+ archers/teams: gold, silver and bronze

- 24. A single prize will be awarded to the tournaments highest individual Junior score.
- 25. A single prize will be awarded to the tournaments highest individual Ladies score.
- 26. A single prize will be awarded to the tournaments highest individual Gentlemen's score.
- 27. Archers will be contacted via provided email, to arrange delivery of medals/prizes/badges.
- 28. Rounds may be shot at your club, shop or private range with insurance.
- 29. Archers must be a current member of a World association for the duration of the tournament.
- 30. All rounds are shot under your clubs, club day rules.
- 31. Entrants, are solely responsible for the safety at the location used for this competition.
- 32. Tournament Organisers decision shall be final in all matters.
- 33. By submitting an entry to this tournament, you are accepting all the rules and conditions of the tournament.
