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3.2. Practice Field and Competition Field

The practice field is organized on the field next to the tent.

Competition field is a field with natural grass. The official practice and all team finals will be organized on the same, but reorganized field.

All gold finals will be shot alternate and will have live coverage.

Also some other matches during the team competition will have live coverage on internet.

3.3. Competition Program (attached)

The latest competition program is published on Ianseo. Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date-hour it was printed.

3.4 Practice and Warm up

Official Practice (2,5 hours) shooting AB-CD format:

- Wednesday 15:00 – 19:00
- Tuesday 7:30 – 9:00
- Friday 7:30 – 9:00
- Friday for Team competition ????
- Saturday 7:30 – 9:00

Warm up will be organized on the competition field as it is scheduled in the attached program. Schedule may be modified if necessary.

3.5. Equipment Inspection

Equipment inspection will follow the program of the official practice and will be held at the tent beside the Event Marque.

- Spare equipment and accreditation card must also be brought for inspection.
- The start number will be given at the registration on Wednesday and Thursday, it will not be changed during the competition.
- The start list will be published before the start of the official practice.
- There is no access to the competition field before or without accreditation is done.

The correct spelling of athlete's names, as well as the correct date of birth in the archers' list will be checked during the accreditation.

3.6. Shooting Round & Information on scoring

Target assignments will be published only on boards and on internet.

Shooting in shooting rounds will be conducted with 4-6 archers per target.

The athletes will have double scoring from all shooting rounds: two paper scorecard.

All the athletes on the same target must verify that the correct scores are entered.

Please instruct your athletes to fill in properly the scorecards including total score, and sign the card before handing them back after each round. Double scoring is required and after the team match also the winner has to be marked.



In case of tied score on positions 1,2 or 3, a shoot off will be arranged. Neutral targets will be used.

3.7. Shooting Rounds

We will keep to the starting time at the beginning of the session and then the competition will run as it goes. Therefore team matches could start sooner than the time indicated in the schedule. Please be aware of this and be prepared for it.

Byes by team matches are allowed. In case of a bye, archers will be allowed to shoot, but no score will be recorded or allowed to be displayed.

3.8. Team Eliminations and Finals

The Team Elimination Round will start with the 1/8. Gold medal matches will be organized with alternating shooting –for teams on Friday.

Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, teams will be allowed to shoot on the competition field, but no score will be recorded or allowed to be displayed.

Remember that the composition of the team can be changed in writing at least 1 hour before the start of that round of competition – see art. 4.3.2. below. The form is attached at the end of this document.

3.8.1. Team

- 2 sets of 3 arrows, 1 arrows per archer. Team with the highest score wins the match.

3.8.2. Shooting

Two teams shoot simultaneously on a course at their own targets. After the first three 3D targets (first flock) the teams change to the other three 3D targets (second flock) on the same course.

the other three 3D targets (second flock) on the same course. When both teams have shot at targets, the arrows are scored.

Shoot-off in Team eliminations and Finals with simultaneously shooting is just one arrow each archer, 60 sec per team. In Bronze and Gold medal matches with alternating shooting the archers are alternating after every single arrow.

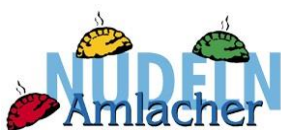

3.9. Team Bronze and Gold Medal Matches



All Gold medal teammatches, will have alternate shooting.

3.10. Appeal Procedure (Form attached)

An Appeal form is attached to this document.

In case of Intent to Appeal or an actual Appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form must be considered.

The Appeal form should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission or to his deputy. A fee of 25 EUR must be paid to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the Appeal to be valid.

If the Appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. In the case of the Appeal being rejected, the fee will not be returned.

4) Technical Matters (TCO + chairman of Judges)

4.1. Timing Control system

The Damage timing equipment will be used for timing with several displays on the practice field.

4.2. Results system

Ianseo is the provider of the results. The scoring in the will be done by the archers. Both archer will write down the score on the paper score sheet. The other archer verifies that the correct scores are entered.

4.3. Rules that apply in this event

4.3.1. Practice on the competition field during byes

Practice on the competition field during byes will be limited to six arrows per end. If more than six arrows are shot by an athlete in an end after being warned by a judge, the athlete may be denied further practice on the competition field but any such violation shall not affect the next match.

4.3.2. Team members' nomination

A team consists of 3 archers and one coach:

1st archer Longbow (LB), Historical Bow (HB)

2nd Compound or Recurve (FU, BU, BL, FS-R, FS-C)

3rd archer Bow Hunter (BH-R, BH-C), Bare Bow (BB-R, BB-C), Traditional Bow (TR)

unless the team manager notifies the Chairman of Judges in writing at least 1 hour before the start of that round of competition of a substitution of another athlete who competed in the Qualification Round. The teams must be registered by name before the start of the tournament (qualifying rounds). Only complete teams can be registered. Entry with a zero score is not possible. Only shooters in the age groups Adults, Young Adults, Veterans and Seniors may be entered in the team competition. (they shoot at all targets from the same peg in the individual competition). If a team member is unable to complete the qualification competition due to

health reasons or an irreparable technical defect, a substitute member can be nominated, whose score will then also be taken into account for the ranking.

4.3.3. Archers acting as Coaches

Archers may be acting as coaches during team matches.

4.3.4. Shoot-offs - Individual:

In the event of a tie for any award the archers concerned will break the tie by a shoot-off over three 3D targets (two arrows per target) set up on the practice range at "group 1" distances. The target for the first round shall be a "group 1" target, that for the second round shall be a "group 2" target and that for the third round shall be a group 3 target. If the tie is not then broken, they will continue shooting a single arrow "sudden death" on the group 3 target, which will be moved further back after each arrow..

4.3.5. Shoot-offs - Teams:

In all rounds, if the number of rings is equal, a shoot-off shall be carried out on a separate 3D target.

- 1) Each shooter shoots one arrow.
- 2) The shooting time for the team is one minute.
- 3) Both teams shoot at the same time.
- 4) Score 10, 8, 5, M for each arrow.
- 5) The winner is the team with the higher number of rings.
- 6) If the number of rings is equal, the arrow closest to the centre decides. If the distance of the arrows of both teams is the same, the 2nd arrow decides. If they are also equal, the 3rd arrow decides.
- 7) If no decision has been made after this procedure, the shoot-off is repeated.

4.4. Rankings

After the end of this event, the Ranking will be prepared and published at Ianseo.net.

The awarding will take place in the tent immediately after the results entry has been completed and the objection period has elapsed.

4.5. Dress Instructions

Athletes, officials and staff should have a proper appearance when they are on the field during competition. Athletes, team officials and technicians should wear their national or club uniforms and mountain boots.

Opened shoes are not allowed on the field of play and on practice field.

We would like to remind all teams that names of archers and country code are appreciated for this event.

Camouflage is prohibited according to the competition rules of the Austrian Archery Association.



4.6. Lost arrows

All lost and found arrows are to be reported to the judges.

It is very important to report lost arrows as we are in a grazing field and any arrow left on the field can cause serious injury to the animals.

5) Logistical Aspects (OC)

5.1. Transportation:

There is a shuttle between event area and campsite.
Schedule is online at Ianse competition site.

5.3. Starter Cards rules

The starter card must be worn at all times in the practice and competition areas.

6. Protocol and ceremonies (OC)

6.1. Opening

There is no opening ceremony. Only a short welcome speech will be organized before the start of official practice.

6.2. Medal Ceremonies and Closing Ceremony

Medal ceremonies will be conducted separately for teams and individuals.

All archers involved in the ceremonies are requested to go to the gathering point ASAP in order to proceed quickly and smoothly with the award ceremony.

After awarding the medallists all gold medallists have to stay on the field for the picture. All teams are kindly asked to stay on the field till the end of the medal ceremony.

There will be short closing ceremony. The event will finish officially after the last medal ceremony at the finals venue.

7. Medical Related issues (Medical representative)

There is a doctor responsible for the First Aid on the field. In emergency the ambulance will be called.

In case of emergency during your stay in the hotel, please inform the reception and proper arrangements will be made.

8. Doping Control

8.1. Doping control

Doping control are always possible through the tournament.

8.2. Alcohol test

Alcohol control are always possible through the tournament.
Alcohol is strictly prohibited through the tournament.



9. Other matters of importance (TCO)

9.1. The environment

We ask you to instruct your athletes to use the litter bins which are placed behind the waiting area and over all ranges.

9.2. Water

It is important to mention that the tap water in Bad Kleinkirchheim is drinkable, clean and fresh. Your bottle can be filled with water anywhere in the hotel as well as also on the field.

9.3. Non smoking and no alcohol

This is a non smoking event for the practice and official competition areas. Inside sport area you are not allowed to smoke, you must use the designated areas outside the sport field and on the ranges. The same is valid also for electronic cigarettes. Also alcohol consumption is forbidden.

9.4 Information System

- Due to environmental preservation and responsible behavior toward nature we will not have very less printed material.
- Printed documents will be published only on the board at the competition venue.
- All competition documents will be published <http://www.ianseo.net>
- There will be live TV streaming during team matches.
- The official results will be published immediately after the conclusion of the competition.

All lost items will be brought to the tent and the cash desk, so ask there if you lost something.

Die Absicht einen Protest einzulegen, der Einfluss auf das Vorrücken eines Wettkämpfers von einer Phase des Wettkampfes zur nächsten hat, muss innerhalb von 5 Minuten nach Beendigung des jeweiligen Matches oder gegebenenfalls der Runde dem Leitenden Kampfrichter und der Jury gegenüber schriftlich geäußert werden.

Während der Finalrunden, die nach dem Match System geschossen werden, muss die Absicht Protest einzulegen innerhalb von 5 Minuten nach Beendigung des Matches oder vor Beginn des folgenden Matches, je nachdem was zuerst stattfindet, angekündigt werden.

Artikel 3.13.3.2:

Der Schriftliche Protest muss bei der Jury binnen 15 Minuten nach Ende der relevanten Runde oder des relevanten Matches, je nachdem was zuerst eintritt, eingereicht werden.

Eine Gebühr von Euro 25.- muss für einen Einspruch hinterlegt werden.

Diese Gebühr wird erstattet, wenn dem Einspruch stattgegeben wird oder wenn die Jury den Einspruch für angemessen hält.

Sobald ein Einspruch eingelegt worden ist, muss dies bekannt gegeben werden.
