## Stage 4 - Midlands, hosted by Meriden Archery Club

World Record Status

**Date & Timings:** Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> August 2023. **No** arrivals before 07:45am; Registration & Inspection from 08:15am; Assembly 09:00am followed by practice.

**Location:** Meriden Archery Club, Forest Grounds, Birmingham Rd, Meriden, CV7 7JS [Find Meriden AC](#)

**Rounds:** A single WA 70/60/50m plus AGB 122/30m & 80/30m ranking rounds (see tables below) in the morning, followed by head to head eliminations in the afternoon.

**Judges** Jo Orford, Andrew Stanford, Fiona Macpherson, Matt Alcock, Carlene Wright

**Entry & Fees:** Entry is via the ClubEvent, [Clubevent.co.uk](http://Clubevent.co.uk), fee is £17.50 - Closing date is Sunday 13th August or when the event is full, and strictly no refunds after Friday 4th August.  
This shoot is also part of the Central England Junior Open in which separate awards are made

**Bosses:** Tenzone layered foam bosses

**Rules:** WA Rules and Archery GB dress regulations will apply.  
Music may be played during the event.

**Awards:** Top 3 places in each eligible age category (see JAS rules)

**Divisions:** Compound, Recurve, & Barebow (see distance table below)

**Classes:** U21, U18, U15, U12 (see year of birth table below)

**Tents & Practice** Tents are permitted and can be put up from 4:45pm on Friday (18th), however no camping is permitted. Those wishing to practice can do so from 5pm-6:45pm, as long as they are signed in by a Meriden Member.

**Food** Hot and cold drinks along with a selection of cakes and pastries will be available throughout the day if you can please bring your own mug.

**Facilities:** Ladies and gents toilet block on the field.

**Smoking/Alcohol:** Adults - Smoking/Vaping is **only** permitted behind the last row of tents. No alcohol is allowed on the field.

**Liability:** Meriden AC will not be liable for damage to cars or other property at the event.

**Dogs:** Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times.

**Camping** There are unfortunately no camping facilities at Meriden Archery Club, and the Club will lock the gates at 7pm with no access thereafter.
