3.1 Number of participants per class

Qualification Round Practice

- 2 ends of practice before the qualification starts on the Field of Play, 3 minutes per end.

3.4 Equipment Inspection

- During official practice on the 15 of March
- Teams will be announced in alphabetical order by DOS
- All teams are to wear their team uniform
- Spare equipment must also be brought for inspection
- Team managers are to check the personal details of their athletes (names, DOB, etc.).
- Inform the Judge if details are not correct and the judge will inform Result Team
- Athletes' numbers will be issued on the day of the qualification round during practice
- Athletes' numbers must be attached on the quiver, facing the waiting line while shooting.

3.5 Qualification Round and scoring information

- Compound Women / Recurve Men– 16 March
70m Round (72 arrows) for Recurve
50m Round (72 arrows)
- Compound Men / Recurve Women– 16 March
70m Round (72 arrows) for Recurve
50m Round (72 arrows)

3.6 Individual Elimination Round

- Target faces will NOT be changed after practice arrows. Please instruct your archers to mark all the arrows holes during practice.
- Matches will start as soon as the field is ready.
- Matches at the start of each session will begin on time. Proceeding matches will follow up on the immediate completion of the prior match. Archers should be alert and prepared for their matches to start slightly earlier than scheduled.
- Byes are permitted. In case of a bye, archers might be allowed to shoot on their own target, provided the competition allows. If the competition schedule allows, no score will be recorded or displayed and the archers shooting as bye must respect the DOS timing and signals of the competition. All bye recurve and compound archers are permitted to shoot 3/5 sets of practice.
- Individual elimination round will start at the 1/24 elimination stage, in each category or less depending on the entries)
- There will be no alternate shooting during the preliminary elimination rounds.

3.6.1 Recurve Elimination

- The set system will be used for all individual, Team and mixed team matches. Individual matches will consist of the best of 5 sets, (3 / 6 / 4 arrows per set) and the archer who will first reach a minimum of 6 (5 for Team) set points wins the match.
- All matches, up to and including the semi-final Match, will be shot simultaneously.

3.6.2 Compound Elimination

- Matches for all compound events will use cumulative scoring, consisting of 5 ends of 3/ 6 / 4 arrows per end. The archers /Team / Mixed Team with the highest cumulative score wins the match.
- All matches, up to and including the semi-final Match, will be shot simultaneously on the qualification range for the individual events.

3.7 Team and Mixed Teams Elimination Round – (See document attached for schedule)

- No alternate shooting
- Byes permitted, Teams will be allowed to shoot on their allocated target, but no score will be recorded or display

3.7.1 Recurve Team and Mixed Team – (See document attached for schedule)

- Team and mixed team will consist of the best 4 sets (6 arrows per team and 4 arrows per mixed team). The team that reaches a minimum of 5 set points first will win the match. All matches, up to and including the Bronze Match, will be shot simultaneously on the qualification range for the individual, team and mixed team events.

3.7.2 Compound Team and Mixed Team – (See document attached for schedule)

- Matches for all compound events will use cumulative scoring, consisting of 4 ends of 4/6 arrows.
- All matches, up to and including the Bronze Match, will be shot simultaneously on the qualification range for the team and mixed team events.

3.8 Individual Final Round and Team Final Round – (See document attached for schedule)

- Practice and Warm up field - Will have target in the same direction to the Fop Final
- Competing Archers can practice at the designated practice field before their match
- Alternate shooting at the FOP Final

3.9 Appeal Procedure (Form attached)

- An Appeal form is attached to this document (See Attached)
- In case of an Intent to Appeal or an actual Appeal, indicated time on the Appeal form must be considered.
- Appeal Form should be given to the Chairman of Tournament Judge Commission or to their deputy.
- A fee of **US\$ 50** must be paid to the Chairman of Tournament Judge Commission for the Appeal to be valid.
- If the Appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. If the case of the Appeal begins rejected, the fee will not be returned.

4. Technical Matter (TD / CJ)

4.1 Timing Control system

- Timing equipment with Visual and Audio will be used

4.2 Result System

- Qualification Round – scoring will be done by archers. One archer record, on the official scorecard, the scores of all other archers on that target. At the same time, another archer on the same target will enter all the score of the archers on that target into the scoring tablet. The other archer should verify that all score is written and entered correctly.
- Scorecards **MUST** be signed by the archer and have the full total completed; in case of NON-conformity, the archer will be Disqualified (DSQ).
- Scorecards with the 10's + X's and X count **NOT COMPLETED WILL BE COUNTED AND SCORED AS ZERO "0"**.
- Elimination Round – scoring will be done by archers. One archer/ Team records the arrows values of both archers/ team on the paper scorecard. While at the same time the other archer/team inputs the arrow values in the scoring tablet. **BOTH**

archers/ teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning back to the shooting line.

- At the end of the match, scorecard must be fully completed and signed by the archers involved in the match, otherwise the concerned archer(s) will be Disqualified (DSQ).
- Scoring tablet will be used during the Qualification and Elimination Rounds but not in the Final. (WAA Results & Technology Team is responsible for the results of the event.)
- At the end of the event the World Ranking will be updated

4.3 Rules that apply in this event.

4.3.1 Shooting time

- The total time allowed to shoot an end shall be determined by the total number of arrows to shoot in an end, where:
 - 20 seconds per arrow is the time allowed for individual alternate shooting, and for all team and mixed team rounds including shoot-offs.
 - 30 seconds per arrow is the time allowed for individual shooting during qualifications, Olympic round and Compound rounds where alternate shooting does not apply, including shoot-offs.
 - Qualification Round will be shot with sequence ABC

4.3.2 Qualification Round

- Equipment failure for Medical problems, equipment and 3meter line situation is NOT ALLOWED but Make up arrows, 30s per arrow, for bouncer, pass through, Arrows remaining in target allowed.
- Archers Must stay in field after Qualification, in terms of possible bye, if not, Forfeit

4.3.3 Target set up

- COMPOUND INDIVIDUAL target set up for entrance from Qualification to Elimination only ONE TARGET FACE IN MIDDLE

4.3.4 Finals

- For FINALS, Undersleeves must be white or predominant colour of shirt and for MIXED team, the uniform of COACH and archers must be the same.
- For finals coach must not come out of box and Archers can NOT bring bow up until the green signal is given and clock has started

4.3.5 Accreditation Cards Rules

- All archers and officials are issue with the Accreditation Card
- Accreditation cards must always be worn in the tournament field and during the Equipment inspection.

Article 3.13.2.1:

An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, must be expressed in writing and lodged with the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and/or the Jury within 5 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first. The written appeal must be lodged with the Jury within 15 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first, to allow the Jury to come to a decision before the beginning of the next round of the competition.

Article 3.13.4:

Jury decisions shall be minuted and submitted to the appellant, the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and the Organizers before the beginning of the next stage of the competition or before the awarding of prizes.
