	The shoot off is an elimination format with each archer shooting 3 arrows in 60 seconds at their respective distance (i.e. RU21 at 70m, RU18 at 60m; RU15 at 50m and RU12 shooting at 30m). The archer with the lowest score drops out until we are left with a winner. In the event of a tie then the nearest to the centre rule will apply


