## 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> July 2023 World Record Status

Events:	The weekend is being sold as a single entry over both days. <b>Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> July</b> is the <b>National Tour Stage 4</b> ; a <b>Tier 1</b> WA 70/50m ranking round with Olympic, Compound and Barebow match play. <b>Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> July</b> is a <b>Tier 1</b> WA 70/50m ranking round and H2H. 6 arrows will be shot in 4 minutes on both days.	
Entry	All entries via the <u>Archery GB Membership Portal</u> Public Entry opens Thursday 23rd March 2022 at 7pm.	
Fees & Cancellations	£48 for the weekend. The entry fee less £5 will be refunded for cancellations before 10 <sup>th</sup> June. No refunds from this date. To withdraw, please e-mail the event organisers (saw@surreyarchery.org).	
Categories	Recurve, Compound and Barebow on both days. Longbow Archers shoot as Recurve. All age groups shoot as Seniors.	
Awards	Top three places for Recurve, Compound and Barebow, men & women on both days.	
Timings	<i>Practice:</i> 2pm to 6pm Friday 7 <sup>th</sup> July (note that tents may be erected from noon & the gates are locked at 7pm). <i>Competition days:</i> gates open at 7am. <i>Assembly:</i> 8.30 am followed by 2 ends of practice.	
Venue:	Tolworth Court Sports Ground, Old Kingston Road, Tolworth KT4 7QH. Map: <u>SAW Venue</u>	
Faces	Compound - 80cm 6 ring faces at 50m. Recurve - 122cm faces at 70m. Barebow – 122cm faces at 50m.	
Judges	Paul Clark (Chair), Graham Potts, Andrew Trimble, Mark Davis, Adam Trott, Graham Pink, Alex Purser, Debs Horn, Julie Coates and David Coates.	
Rules	World Archery rules and Archery GB dress regulations, Rule 307, will apply. 6 arrows will be shot in 4 minutes throughout the weekend. Music may be played during the event.	
Bosses	TenZone layered foam bosses.	
Facilities	Toilets provided (inc. disabled) on the field & in the pavilion.	
Food	We hope to return to normal in 2023 with catering provided at the Pavilion Café. If so, a menu will be posted on Ianseo ahead of the event.	

Parking and Travel	Parking on hard standing and on grass behind tent line. Full access for disabled. 5-minute walk from buses and Tolworth Railway station.		
Camping	Camping <u>Horsley</u> or <u>Walton</u> 20 minutes drive – There is no overnight camping on the Tolworth Court Sports Ground.		
Hotels	<u>Premier Inn, Tolworth</u> (closest) / <u>Premier Inn Epsom North</u> / <u>Premier Inn</u> <u>Chessington</u> / <u>Warwick Lodge</u> / <u>Travelodge Chessington Tolworth.</u>		
Dogs	No dogs, other than working assistive dogs, are allowed on site.
