<b>Rounds</b>	<p>Archery GB Imperial Outdoor Rounds – 5 Zone Scoring – 122cm Face – 2 Archers per detail</p> <p>Archery GB Age rules apply i.e.</p> <p>(i) An archer may compete in a junior age group where the tournament takes place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category. <b>Awards</b>	Rose Awards may be claimed when shooting age specific rounds or for juniors shooting up. WAC Open Medals will be awarded per round, division and class, subject to entry numbers ie 1 to 2 entries - Gold only, 3 to 4 entries Gold and Silver, 5 or more entries Gold, Silver and Bronze. Results will be available at the field and online via <a href="http://ianseo.net">ianseo.net</a>																																			
<b>Entry &amp; Fees</b>	Entry is via the AGB Portal, <a href="http://agb.sport80.com">agb.sport80.com</a> , The entry fee is £22 per entry. There will be no refunds after 8 <sup>th</sup> September. Any refunds are made less transaction fees which the club cannot recover.																																			
<b>Bosses</b>	Tenzon layered foam bosses will be used, with straw bosses for Longbow and Bristol II - V rounds.																																			
<b>Rules</b>	Archery GB Rules of Shooting																																			
<b>Divisions</b>	<p>Archers may choose to shoot Recurve, Compound, Longbow or Barebow for all rounds and can shoot up/down their age related group if they wish, although Rose awards will not be awarded if shooting down.</p> <p>Due to field restrictions we can only run 5 York targets (so 20 spaces in total). As such archers are advised to enter early to secure their place.</p>																																			
<b>Classes</b>	Men, Women, 50+ Men & Women and Juniors.																																			
<b>Food</b>	Hot bacon, sausage and burgers will be available from the BBQ, along with a selection of cold drinks and snacks.																																			
<b>Facilities</b>	Ladies and gents toilet block on the field.																																			
<b>Smoking/Alcohol</b>	Smoking/Vaping allowed behind the tents only. No alcohol is allowed on the field.																																			
<b>Liability</b>	Woking Archery Club will not be liable for damage to cars or other property at the event.																																			
<b>Dogs</b>	Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times.																																			
<b>Photos &amp; Video</b>	By entering the WAC Open, you agree that photographs or video may be taken at the event. Photographers are reminded that images must not be used on the internet without the permission of those pictured. Woking Archery Club may take general pictures of the event which may be used to report on or promote future events.
