Date: 01st October 2023, to 29th February 2024 (closing date for entries 24th September 2023)
Time: Archers may shoot this tournament on any club days during the month as this is an outdoor round and the weather may not be kind.

Round: Frostbite (three dozen arrows)
Frostbite: 30 Metres, All age groups,
(Men and Women 50+, Over 21, Under 21, Under 18, Under 16, Under 15, Under 14, Under 12)
Archers may shoot up an age group BUT NOT down, accept for the 50+ age group.

Format: Individual tournament. Decided by the highest combined score of archers best THREE scores.
Ties will be determined by most number of X's and then hits.

Rules: Archery GB and Archery GB dress regulations, Rule 307, will NOT apply.

Venue: Canford Magna Bowmen, Cobhams Sports & Social Club

Shooting Procedure: Ends of six arrows or ends of three arrows will be shot in four minutes, following one end of sighters.

Awards: Medal will be awarded in all classes based on the following entries.
1 archer: gold only
4 archers: gold and silver
7+ archers: gold, silver and bronze

Tournament will run from October 1st 2023 to 29th February 2024 inclusive

Archers will shoot on a 80cm ten ring or 6 ring, single-spot face

Archers will shoot thirty six (36) arrows from thirty metres

Scoring is the metric scoring system. X,10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, M Compound archers 10 are only the small inner, inner 10

Archers may shoot this tournament on a club day of their choice, **BUT** submit **ONLY** one score. (Complete rounds must be shot in one session)

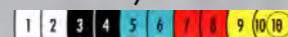
Archers may shoot ends of either three arrows or six arrows

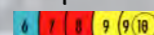

Frostbite Round achievement badges for archers scoring over 200 points in a submitted round will be awarded. (One badge will be awarded based on best score shot over the tournament, badge increments are either 25, 10 & 5 points approaching maximum score)

All scores must be witnessed by another archer/scorer
Phone apps maybe used to record and submit results
Completed score sheets should be handed to the tournament Organiser, alternatively they can be submitted via the I@nseo ScoreKeeper App, or alternatively score sheets can be submitted via email, (matt@drumheights.net)
Score sheets must be submitted by 19:00 on the last day of the month, no exceptions
Details of tournament results, including score sheets will be on the I@nseo website, which will be updated once results all of a months results are received
Main tournament will be decided by highest combined score of an archers best three scores. Ties to be determined by most X's and then hits
All rounds are shot under clubs, club day rules
Entrants, are solely responsible for the safety at the location used for this competition
Tournament Organisers decision shall be final in all matters
