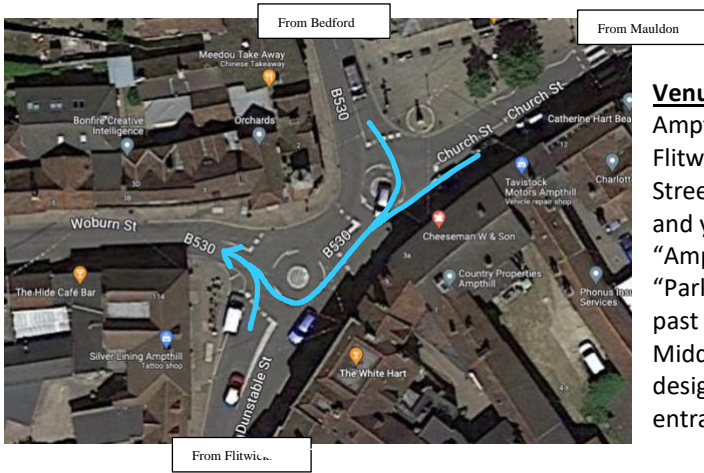

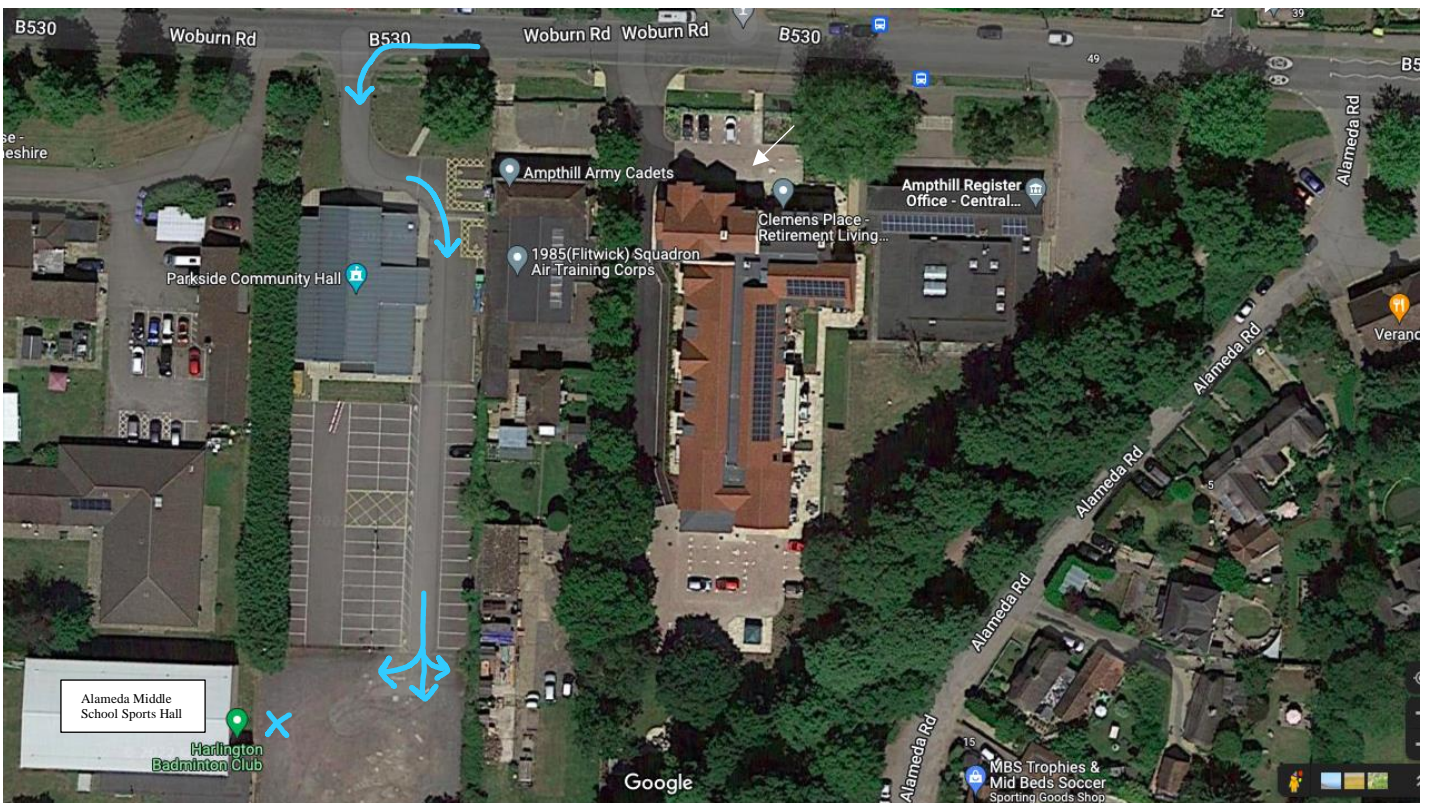

<b>Shooting</b>	Four archers per boss in two details of two. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Portsmouth</b> ends of 3 arrows in 2 minutes.</li> </ul> <i>Note. As per current AGB rules. Those archers entering a second or third round on the day will be allowed sighters.</i>

<b>Closing Date</b>	Midnight Saturday 11 <sup>th</sup> November 2023 or when full, if before. Late entries will be subject to availability No refunds after closing date.	
<b>Entry Allocation</b>	The tournament will be strictly limited to 9 bosses. Entries MUST be accompanied by BANK TRANSFER PAYMENT before a place will be allocated. If no space is available, we will operate a waiting list but only until the closing date. On the days of the tournament spare spaces will be allocated on the basis of 'first come, first served' -- so be early! Any archer not booked in by the published Assembly time will be assumed not to be competing and their space may be reallocated. <b>Equipment inspection</b>	After assembly and before sighters for each round.
<b>Dress</b>	AGB Dress regulations Rule (307) apply and will be enforced. Footwear with a non-marking sole is required in the hall
<b>Facilities</b>	There is only limited seating available - please bring a chair suitable for use in a sports hall if required.
<b>Drug Testing</b>	Record status shoots are liable for Drug Testing. Any competitor approached to give samples for testing MUST comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Where an entry is for a junior entry, the parent or legal guardian of the junior archer must countersign the entry form.
<b>Awards</b>	<p>Medals will be awarded based on the highest score for each bow style, age classification &amp; gender per round.</p> <p>Awards presented will vary based on number of archers per group:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1-2 archers = Gold medal.</li> <li>• 3 archers = Gold &amp; Silver medal.</li> <li>• 4 plus archers = Gold, Silver &amp; Bronze medals</li> </ul>

**Venue and location:** Approaching the roundabout in the centre of Ampt Hill, take the B530 Woburn Street towards Ampt Hill Great Park. Flitwick road towards Ampt Hill town centre. Continue along Woburn Street, pass Alameda road on your left, Russel Court on your right and you will see on your left “The Ampt Hill Register Office”, then the “Ampt Hill Cadet Centre (Army & ATC)”. The next building will be the “Parkside Community centre”. Turn into the entrance and continuing past the main building to the back where you will find the Alameda Middle school Sports hall. X marks the spot. Please proceed to the designated parking area. Disabled Parking will be reserved close to the entrance to the Sports hall.
