

WOAC INDOOR CHALLENGE 2023/2024

The **WOAC Indoor Challenge** will be run every indoor Season with the winners in each category receiving a trophy and a medal. Medals will also be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each category. Trophies must be returned the following year in a good and clean condition for awarding to the new WOAC Indoor Challenge Champions.

WHAT IS THE WOAC INDOOR CHALLENGE?

This is an Indoor competition for WOAC Members only.

The WOAC Indoor Challenge will consist of 3 different scored rounds over the course of the Indoor Season. Archers <u>MUST</u> shoot the same bowstyle for all 3 of the scored rounds. Rankings for The Finals will be based on a league Table. Archers must shoot at least 2 of the 3 Scored Rounds to be entered into The Finals.

The WOAC Indoor Challenge for the 2023 / 2024 Winter Indoor Shooting Season will take place at The Sports Hall at Wollaston School.

DIVISIONS

The divisions will be the same as last year's Tournament and will consist of the following: -

- Recurve
- Compound
- Barebow
- Longbow
- Flatbow

All other bows will be entered as Barebow and will need to conform to the Barebow Rules as set out in the World Archery Rule Book – <u>Book 3 / Chapter 11 / 11.4 Barebow Division</u>.

All bows used must comply with the Bowstyle description for Target Archery within the Archery GB Rules of Shooting.

CLASS

Adult Archers – All archers in a Division will be grouped together and ranked from the Results of the three Qualifying / Ranking Rounds. Adults will be classed as anyone turning 18 within the year of 2024 i.e., if you were born in the year 2007 or earlier.

Junior Archers – The Age groups for Junior Archers was changed by Archery GB on the 1st October 2022. For this tournament the new Age Groups will be in use and will be based on your year of birth as per the new Archery GB age ruling. For The Finals Junior Archers will be as per their class as of 1st January 2024. All archers in a Division will be grouped together regardless of Age Class and gender. Juniors may if they wish, choose to shoot in the adult Class. Juniors will be anyone who falls into the Under 18 Class from 1st January 2024.

QUALIFYING / RANKING ROUNDS

The Rounds to be shot as the Qualifying / Ranking Rounds will be: -

• Saturday 9th December 2023 PORTSMOUTH

Saturday 13th January 2024 WORCESTER

• Saturday 24th February 2024 WA18m

• Saturday 16th March 2024 The Finals - Head-To-Heads

THE FINALS

The Head to Heads will be shot in ends of 3 using the Sets Scoring System (ie 2 points for an end win, 1 for a draw) with the exception of Compound archers who will shoot 1 ¼ dozen in 3 arrow ends with the highest score winning.

All Head-To-Heads will be shot at 20 Yards.

Adult Recurve, Barebow, Longbow and Flatbow will shoot at 60cm Full Target Faces.

Adult Compound will shoot at 60cm Vertical 3-Spot Target Faces.

Juniors – All divisions will shoot at 60cm Full Target Faces.

FEES

There will be a fee of £15 to enter the Indoor Challenge. This covers the 3 shoots and The Finals.
