## 3) Technical Aspects of the Competition (OC + TCO)

### 3.1. Number of Participants **1.608 on May 15**

### 3.2. Practice Field and Ranges

The practice field is located on the field next to the Event Marquee.

Eight ranges are located in or near Bad Kleinkirchheim.

**All ranges and the practice field are under video surveillance!**

### 3.3. Competition Program

The actual competition program is published on Ianseo [Home | Ianseo](#) and on the website <https://ebhc2024.com/> . Each official competition schedule will indicate the version number and the date and time of publication.

### 3.4. Practice and Warm-up

Official Practice:

- Friday 15:00 – 19:00
- Saturday 09:00 – 18:00
- Sunday 09:00 – 15:00

Monday until Friday (competition days):

Guided practice for Standard Round archers only 07:00 - 07:45

Guided practice only for UAR archers only 08:00 – 08:45

Guided practice only for HU archers only 09:00 – 09:45

After the daily Official Practice, the practice field is open for archers from 10:00 - 18:00, unguided training is possible. The schedule may be modified if necessary.

### 3.5. On-site Registration

Registration will follow the program of the Official Practice and will be held at the Event Marquee.

The archers must bring following documents:

- Score Records & Classification Card
- Starter Card
- Score cards
- Bow equipment form (two copies)
- All equipment has to be brought along
- Tell during the registration whether something has changed in the bow class or age group.

The correct spelling of the archer's name, as well as the correct date of birth in the archers' list will be checked during the registration.

### 3.6. Equipment Inspection

Equipment inspection will follow the program of the Official Practice and will be held in the Event Marquee.

- Equipment, spare equipment, bow equipment form (two copies) and Starter Card must also be brought for inspection.



**There is no access to the practice field or the ranges before or without registration and equipment inspection are done.**

### 3.7. Shooting Rounds & Information on Scoring

#### **All score cards are collected in the goodiebag**

The archers are grouped in groups of 4-6 archers per target.

The start list will be published before the start of the Official Practice on each competition day. Target assignments will be published only on the boards in the Event Marquee, on the internet [Home | Ianseo](#) and on the EBHC personal Assistant APP.

We will keep to the starting time at the beginning of the day and then the competition will run as it goes. Please be aware of this and be prepared for it.

The archers will have double scoring in all shooting rounds: two paper scorecards.  
All archers on the same target must verify that the correct scores are entered.

**Please instruct your archers to fill in the scorecards properly including total score and sign the card before handing them back after each round. Double scoring is required. If any scorecards are not filled out accurately, the Range Marshall will return all scorecards of the affected group.**

**Please advise your archers that the scorecards are only to be handed back every day at a specially marked place on the respective range. Scorecards that are not returned on the respective range will not be accepted.**

#### 3.7.1. Shooting termination

A separate signal horn will sound for each range, in case of thunderstorm or other important reasons.

### 3.8. Protest Procedure (Form Attached)

A Protest Form is attached to this document.

In case of an Intention to protest or an actual Protest, the times indicated in the Rules must be considered.

The Protest Form should be given to the Chairman of the Protest Committee or to a nominated Representative. A fee of 100 EUR must be paid for the Protest to be valid.

If the Protest is upheld by the Protest Committee, the fee will be returned. In the case of the Protest being rejected, the fee will not be returned.

## 4) Technical Matters (OC, TCO + Result Team)

### 4.1. Timing Control System

The Chronotir timing equipment will be used for timing with several displays on the practice field.

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## 4.2. Results System

Ianseo is the provider of the results. The scoring will be done by the archers. The two Scorers will write down the scores on the paper score sheets. The other archers verify that the correct scores are entered.

## 4.3. Rules that Apply in this Event

### 4.3.1. Team Members' Nomination

**Only archers in the age groups Adults, Young Adults, Veterans and Seniors may be entered in the team competition.**

A **Style Team** consists of 3 archers regardless of gender and they may nominate a fourth archer (as a reserve).

Only complete teams can be registered. An entry with a zero score is not possible.

A **CON Team** consists of 9 archers (Champion of Nations).

A team of less than nine may be entered if the nation cannot fill all style slots.

**The teams must be registered by name on Sunday between 16:00 – 20:00.**

**We accept only written nominations and only from the Team Manager, accompanied by the required team registration fees (in cash).**

**Nomination forms are attached at the end of this document.**

### 4.3.2. Shoot-offs – Individual

In the event of a tie for any award, a shoot-off will be arranged. Neutral 3D targets will be used. Shoot-offs will be held at the practice field.

Shoot-offs will be organized on the last day of the competition (Friday) of the division concerned as soon as the results are in.

In the event of a tie for any award the archers concerned will break the tie by a shoot-off over three 3D targets (two arrows per target) set up on the practice field at "group 1" distances. The target for the first round shall be a "group 1" target, that for the second round shall be a "group 2" target and that for the third round shall be a "group 3" target. If the tie is not then broken, they will continue shooting a single arrow "sudden death" on the "group 3" target from a further distance.

## 4.4. Rankings

After the end of this event, the final Ranking will be prepared and published on [Home | Ianseo](#) .

The awarding will take place in the Event Marquee on Saturday 09:00 after completion of the entry of results and the expiry of the objection period. See also chapter 6.2.

## 4.5. Dress Instructions

Archers, officials, and staff should have a proper appearance when they are on the field during





competition. Archers, team officials, and technicians are kindly asked to wear their national or club uniforms and mountain boots.

**Open shoes are not allowed on the practice field and on the ranges.**

Camouflage is not desired, according to the competition rules of the Austrian Archery Association.

According to the IFAA rules, the archers are strongly advised to wear bright clothing on the ranges. Full cameo clothing will not be allowed on the ranges without a high visibility item.

#### 4.6. Lost Arrows

All lost and found arrows are to be reported to the Range Captain or Range Marshall.

**It is very important to report lost arrows as we are in a grazing field and any arrow left in the field can cause serious injury to the animals.**

### 5) Logistical Aspects (OC)

#### 5.1. Transportation

There runs a shuttle between the event site and the campsite.

The Shuttle Bus Timetable is attached at the end of this document and online on [Home | Ianseo](#).

It can also be found on the EBHC personal Assistant APP.

#### 5.2. Meals

The tent is open from 06:30 – 21:00.

On every range will be one refreshment station, two water points and two toilets.

#### 5.3. Starter Card Rules

The Starter Card must be always worn on the practice field and on the ranges.

### 6) Protocol and Ceremonies (OC)

#### 6.1. Opening

There is an opening ceremony on Sunday 19:00 in the Event Marquee. The march of the nations will start at 18:00 from "Sportplatz" Bad Kleinkirchheim. There is a 5 minutes walking distance.

**Please advise your archers that there is no parking space at "Sportplatz".**

A short welcome speech will be organized.

#### 6.2. Medal and Closing Ceremonies

Medal ceremonies will be held on Saturday from 09:00 onwards, it will be conducted separately for teams and individuals.

All archers involved in the ceremonies are requested to go to the gathering point ASAP in order to proceed quickly and smoothly with the award ceremony.

After awarding the medallists, all gold medallists have to stay on the field for the picture. All teams are kindly asked to stay on the field till the end of the medal ceremony.

There will be a short closing ceremony.

### 7) Medical Related Issues (OC)

There is a doctor responsible for First Aid on site. In an emergency, the ambulance will be called.

A helicopter station is 3 minutes flight distance away from the event location.



In case of emergency during your stay in the hotel, please inform the reception and proper arrangements will be made.

## 8) Doping Control (OC)

### 8.1. Doping Control

A doping control is always possible during the tournament.

### 8.2. Alcohol Test

Alcohol is strictly prohibited during the tournament, alcohol consumption is forbidden on the practice field and on the ranges.

Alcohol control is always possible during the tournament.

## 9) Other Matters of Importance (OC)

### 9.1. The Environment

We ask you to instruct your archers to use the litter bins which are placed on the venue and at all ranges.

### 9.2. Water

It is important to mention that the tap water in Bad Kleinkirchheim is drinkable, clean and fresh. Your bottle can be filled with water anywhere in the hotels as well as on the ranges.

### 9.3. Smoking

**This is a nonsmoking event. Our Event Marquee is a nonsmoking tent.**

**Smoking is forbidden** on the practice field and official competition areas.

In the sporting areas you are not allowed to smoke, you must use the designated "smoking allowed areas" outside the practice field and the ranges.

The same is also valid for electronic cigarettes.

**If someone is caught smoking on the range, the current day's scores will be cancelled.**

### 9.4. Dogs

No dogs are allowed on the practice field and on the ranges.
