A single prize will be awarded to the worst white at a single end of the shortest distance as

determined by the Judges/Tournament Organiser.

A single penguin prize award to the first archer to hit the marked penguin.

A petticoat tournament will be run by the Tournament Organiser, if there is enough interest, at a £2

entry fee, 25% going to charity.


