

Dave Lawrence 2nd Memorial Shoot

- Date:** Sunday 15th September 2024, (closing date for entries 1st September 2024)
- Time:** Archers Assembly: 08:30, Shooting starts after with one end of sighters
- Round:** National Round, (four dozen arrows at longer distance and two dozen arrows at shorter)
National: 60 Yards and 50 Yards, (Women and Men, Over 18)
National 50: 50 Yards and 40 Yards, (Women U18 and Men U16)
National 40: 40 Yards and 30 Yards, (Women U16 and Men U14)
[Other distances may be available on request and subject to space]
- Format:** Individual tournament. Ties will be determined by most number of Golds.
- Rules:** Archery GB and Archery GB dress regulations, Rule 307, will apply.
- Venue:** Canford Magna Bowmen, Cobhams Sports & Social Club
- Shooting Procedure:** Ends of six arrow will be shot in four minutes, following one end of sighters at the longest distance.
- Awards:** Medal will be awarded in all classes based on the following entries, archers shooting down distance will not be eligible for medals.
1 archer: gold only
4 archers: gold and silver
7+ archers: gold, silver and bronze
The Dave Lawrence Memorial Trophy, awarded to the archer with highest tournament handicapped score.
A single colour prize will be awarded to the first archer to hit the marked colour.
A single prize will be awarded to the best gold at a single end of the longest distance as determined by the Judges/Tournament Organiser.
A single prize will be awarded to the worst white at a single end of the shortest distance as determined by the Judges/Tournament Organiser.
A single penguin prize award to the first archer to hit the marked penguin.
A petticoat tournament will be run by the Tournament Organiser, if there is enough interest, at a £2 entry fee, 25% going to charity .
