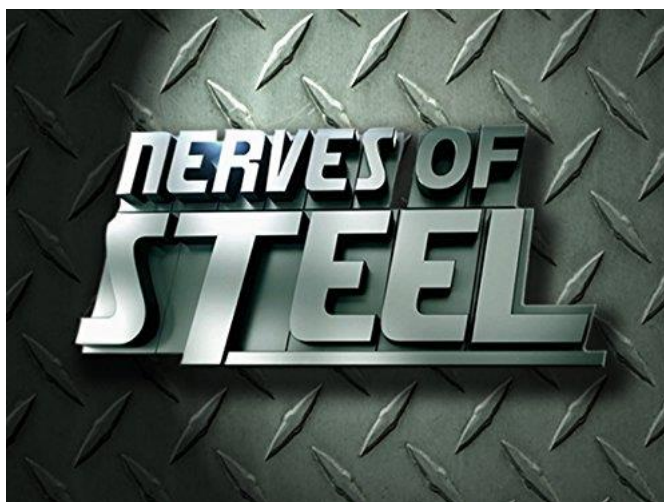

Drug testing	All archers attending this tournament will be liable for drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply, if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be acknowledged by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.
Notes	Awards offered in each competitor group will be determined by the number of valid entries received for both WoSA members and visiting archers. (Gold, Silver, Bronze) . Trophies will be awarded to WoSA members only.
<u>Under 18</u>	Parents/Guardians will, at all times, be responsible for those under 18 that are present.
