

# 3. For Your Information

Juniors shooting as Seniors	Juniors over the age of 12 are welcome to shoot on an equal footing with senior Archers and compete for the senior medals but must enter and pay as seniors.
Junior Shooting Groups	Junior archers will be assigned to the same target group as their senior family member if shooting. If a senior family member is not shooting, then, Junior members should be accompanied by a parent/family adult/ responsible adult known to the family and assigned to a shooting group with fellow club members sf possible.
Red Call	If emergency assistance is required in the field. <b>The following procedure will apply.</b> The archers call the <b>target number</b> followed by <b>RED</b> . When the call is heard by other archers, they will immediately stop shooting and repeat the call. Shooting will recommence on a whistle. No one will resume shooting until the restart is signalled.
Dress	It is recommended that competitors wear clothing appropriate to the venue and weather conditions. No camouflage clothing permitted
Lost Arrows	In accordance with World Archery rules, searches for lost arrows must not delay shooting groups. When searching for lost arrows, please ensure that 1 archer always remains in front of the boss. If a shooting group arrives at the target, <b>please move on</b> . Please <b>record all lost arrows on your scorecard and</b> record them on the lost arrow sheet upon completion of scoring.
Allergies	Please inform the Tournament Officer prior to the competition,  tournamentofficer@loughcuanbowmen.org if you have any allergies which may affect you or other archers during the competition
Smoking	No smoking (including e-cigarettes and VAPE cigarettes) is permitted on the course.
Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing, competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Noncompliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
GDPR	In submitting your entry to the competition, the following information will be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors to aid the administration of the shoot for example, target lists and results will be published: First Name, Surname, bow style, shooting classification, Email, Club (and ID), University (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info. Information collected will be held to assist club records.





Photography	As a club shoot photography is prohibited on the course; however we request that in line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event register at registration on arrival. Please note in line with the Photographing & Filming Children & Young People in Sport policy you may be required to obtain written permission from the subject and/or their parents/carers to publish images on the internet or in print. Photographs may be taken by LCB (designated marshal) and may be used for the club website, social media, magazine and in publicity articles (e.g., AGB magazine). If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed, they should notify the organisers.
Liability	Neither Lough Cuan Bowmen, or the landowner can accept liability for any property left or damaged at the location

### Where exactly is Clandeboye Estate?





Travelling from Newtownards (Crawfordsburn Road) it is approximately 5 miles.


