<b>Round</b>	<p><b>Double American (60yds, 50yds, 40yds)</b>  <i>A single American round will be shot in the morning with a further single American round shot in the afternoon. Junior archers are welcome to take part but they will be shooting the full American round distances. Juniors wishing to enter will pay the senior fee.</i></p> <p><b>Single American non record status.</b> If you would prefer you can shoot a single American round (non-record status) ~ please specify on the entry form whether you would like to shoot in the morning or afternoon. <i>Spaces will be offered subject to availability.</i></p> <p>Please note we will be shooting ends of 6 arrows at a 122cm face all day. As the field is part of a working farm all arrows MUST be accounted for! Lost arrows should be reported to the judges who should also be advised when missing arrows are found. If shooting full carbon arrows, we prefer that they have pin nocks fitted as this would assist us when searching for potential strays.</p>

<b>Closing Date</b>	<p>Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2024 or when full. Late entries will be accepted if there is sufficient space. Refunds will not be available after the closing date and are at the discretion of the Tournament Organisers  This competition is open to individuals affiliated to Archery GB or a World Archery member association. Please bring proof of membership (Archery GB Membership Card).</p>
<b>Target List</b>	A preliminary target list will be available on The Audco Archers website and lanseo one week before.
<b>Awards</b>	<p><b>Individual Awards.</b> Double Round only – Special Commemorative Medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> place, club medals to 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places. Recurve, Compound, Barebow and Longbow.  Single Round – Club medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place, according to bowstyle.  <b>Juniors may enter this tournament but must shoot as seniors. There will be no separate junior awards.</b></p>

<p><b>Rules</b></p>	<p>Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply. <b>Only clothing in compliance with Rule 307</b> will be permitted. Blue Denim, Olive Drab and Camouflage are not allowed. Archer's names, manufacturers logos, club logos and sponsors logos are allowed. The only other wording or logos permissible must represent archery organisations.</p> <p>The tournament organisers have the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour. The Chairman of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times and the judge's decision is final and must be obeyed.</p>
<p><b>Data Protection</b></p>	<p>Data Protection Notice: When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.</p>
<p><b>Photography</b></p>	<p>In accordance with the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People policy, any person, whether archers or visitors, intending to take photographs, either still or video, are requested to register their intention with the Competitions Officer. Entrants bringing visitors to the tournament are asked to make them aware of this requirement.</p> <p><b>Parents &amp; Guardians:</b> Please be aware that unless indicated on the entry form, you are permitting photographs to be taken of you and the archer(s) named on the entry form by The Audco Archers official photographer, which they may use on their website and social media platforms.</p>
<p><b>Refreshments and Food</b></p>	<p>There will be a BBQ throughout the shoot, serving sausage or bacon baps in the morning and burgers at lunch. Tea, coffee and cold drinks will be available throughout the shoot.</p>
<p><b>Tents and Parking</b></p>	<p>Line tents are permitted for this event and must be sited in the marked areas. Line tents may be erected from 8.00am.</p> <p>Please be aware that no naked flames (e.g. camping stoves) are permitted anywhere on site.</p> <p>Parking will be a little tight, car sharing where possible would be appreciated and please ensure that you park within the designated areas.</p>
<p><b>Walkways and Smoking</b></p>	<p>There will be designated walkways at this event that need to be kept clear. However, if you are asked to move equipment for access, please comply with the request promptly.</p> <p>Smoking, including e-cigarettes and vaping is NOT permitted anywhere on the site.</p> <p>Please ensure that you take your rubbish home with you.</p>
