Closing date is Monday 6th May 2024 or when the event is full, and strictly no refunds after Friday 5th April.

Bosses: Tenzone layered foam bosses / Damage / Foam

Rules: 30 arrows at each of the 60/50/40m distances on 122cm faces.
WA Rules and Archery GB dress regulations will apply.
Music may be played during the event.

Awards: Top 3 places in each eligible age category

Divisions: Compound, Recurve, Longbow & Barebow

Classes: Over 50, Seniors, U21, U18, U15 (see table below)

Tents & Practice Tents are permitted and can be put up from 8am on Sunday 2nd June.

Food Hot and cold drinks along with a selection of hot food will be available throughout the day. Please make sure that any litter is collected from the field before leaving.
