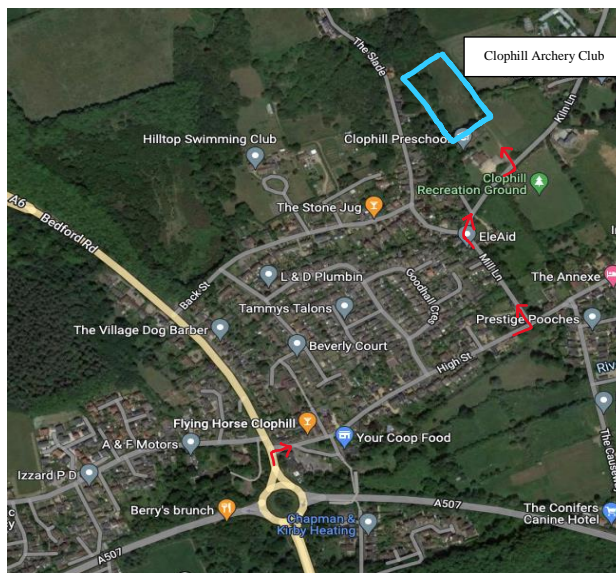

(Sorry, no single round entries) Recurve – 2 x 6 dozen arrows at 70m on 122cm Face (U18 & Master at 60m on 122cm Face) Barebow – 2 x 6 dozen arrows at 50m on 122cm Face Compound – 2 x 6 dozen arrows at 50m on 80cm Face Longbow – 2 x 6 dozen arrows at 70m on 122cm Face (U18 & Master at 60m on 122cm Face)
Entry Fee	£24 per day (Double Round)

Entry Allocation	The tournament will be strictly limited to 12 bosses. Entries MUST be accompanied by BANK TRANSFER PAYMENT before a place will be allocated. If no space is available, we will operate a waiting list but only until the 15th September . On the days of the tournament spare spaces will be allocated based on ‘first come, first served’ -- so be early! Any archer not booked in by the published Assembly time will be assumed not to be competing and their space may be reallocated. Equipment inspection	After registration and before sighters for each round.
Dress	Archery GB Dress regulation rule 307 will apply.
Tents	Will not be required: adequate shelter will be provided behind the shooting line for all archers. Please bring a chair if you want to rest your legs between ends!
Drug Testing	Record status shoots are liable for Drug Testing. Any competitor approached to give samples for testing MUST comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Where an entry is for a junior entry, the parent or legal guardian of the junior archer must countersign the entry form.

Target List and Results	Target lists and results will be sent to individuals who supply an email address and will be published on Clophill Archery Club's website: www.clophillac.co.uk and www.ianseo.net
Photography	In line with Archery GB's Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event must register with the tournament organisers (and provide identification) before Assembly each day. Where other people's children can be identified in pictures or videos please do not share them on social media or in print.
Refreshments	Hot water, tea bags, coffee milk etc will be available all day – £1 (free refills all day). There is a local Co-Op store to the field in the village for refreshments, sandwiches etc. at 4, The Green, Clophill MK45 4AD.
Personal Data	Clophill Archery Club (CAC) needs your permission to collect, use and store personal and other data about you in order to carry out its normal competition administration. Your entry to this event indicates that you consent to this. Some of the information we ask you to provide on the entry form may be shared by the tournament organisers with the judges, your fellow competitors and Archery GB, in connection with this competition only: name, gender, bow style, club, AGB number, round, age category, and wheelchair/stool use. The remaining information (email address, mobile phone number and Junior date of birth) will also be collected but will not be published and will only be available to the Tournament Organisers to enable them to contact the archer and ensure compliance with the rules of competition.

Venue and location: From the A6 trunk road follow the signs Clophill Village, proceed through the village and turn left into Mill Lane (sign-posted to the Village Hall), after 200 yards bear right at the fork into Kiln Lane, after 100 yards turn left into the Village Hall gateway. Please park on the right-hand side of the track leading up to the tournament field. Please park sensibly as we have a lot of vehicles to accommodate. *(Wheelchair archers may drive through the top gate and park within the tournament field itself.)* The site will be open to archers from 0700 on the days of the competition. Toilets are available in the Village Hall and on the field itself for less able archers. Please note that the car park and field are grass and on a slight hill.
