

When: Sunday 19th May 2024, single session with Assembly at 10:00.

Round: WA 720s, shot in ends of 6 arrows. This consists of:

Experienced recurves and longbows shoot WA 70m, 6 dozen at 70m on 122 cm target face.

Novice recurves and longbows shoot WA 60m, 6 dozen at 60m on 122 cm target face.

All barebows shoot WA 50m (Barebow), 6 dozen at 50m on 122 cm target face.

All compounds shoot WA 50m (Compound), 6 dozen at 50m on 80cm reduced (X-5) target face. Some bosses are straw - due to different distances by category it is not possible to request your choice of boss. This competition will fulfil the requirements for a BUCS Outdoors qualifying score.

Head to Heads (H2Hs): Individual, At the same distance and target face as the qualification round. Some categories may be combined for sake of numbers, this will be decided based on entries.

Where: Annex Field, Coombe Dingle Sports Complex, Coombe Ln, Bristol BS9 2BJ. Parking is available on site and the 3, 4 and 1 busses all get you to within walking distance.

Cost: £3 per archer to cover field hire and other costs. It is up to clubs if they pay this on behalf of their archers ask the archers to pay themselves. **Payment** https://www.bristolsu.org.uk/groups/archery-4a65/events/swwu-outdoor-championships-entry-fee

Capacity: ~70 Archers. Allocating this is complicated with different archers shooting different distances - we will let you know if this gets close to full.

Arrows: Full carbon arrows are not permitted. All arrows must be found on the day, if you lose an arrow please report it to a SWWU Coordinator/Judge immediately.

Awards: Results will be published on lanseo. Medals will be awarded to all novice archer medal placings and to experienced archers who have beaten another archer, providing they are not the sole archer in their category.

Lunch: We will break for lunch after the qualifying round. There is a Co-Op ~15 minute walk away in Westbury on Trym.
