## RULES AN REGULATION (ATTACHMENT 1)

FORMAT	<p>INDIVIDUAL QUAIFICATION ROUND:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Each participant has to shoot 2 rounds in the qualifying round, total of 36 arrow for each round. Mean that total of 72 arrow in total. The participant with the highest score will considered as winner.</li><li>• Each round has 6 arrow ends. The participant needs to shoot 6 arrows per end for 180 seconds.</li></ul> <p>Recurve beginner under 10 years men/women:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Double 15 meters (target face 122cm)</li></ul> <p>Recurve under 10 years men/women:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Double 15 meters (target face 122cm)</li></ul> <p>Recurve under 12 years men/women:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Double 30 meters (target face 122cm)</li></ul> <p>Recurve under 16 years men/women:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Double 30 meters (target face 80cm, 6 rings)</li></ul> <p>Recurve open men/women:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Double 30 meters (target face 80cm, 6 rings)</li></ul> <p>INDIVIDUAL ELIMINATION ROUND (EXCEPT FOR BEGINNER CATEGORIES)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>No elimination round for beginner only.</b></li><li>• Top 16 archers from each category will qualified.</li><li>• Each archers need to shoot maximum 5 end each end 3 arrows within 80 second.</li><li>• Who win the end (archers got highest score) will got 2 point, who loose got 0 point. However, if both ties got 1 point each.</li><li>• The archers who reached 6 point first is considered as winner.</li><li>• If both archers get tie in 5 point each, archers need to <b>shoot off 1</b> arrow each within in 30 seconds.</li></ul> <p>Recurve under 10 years men/women (<b>15 meters target face 122cm</b>) Recurve under 12 years men/women (<b>30 meters target face 122cm</b>) Recurve under 16 years men/women (<b>30 meters target face 80cm 6 rings</b>) Recurve open men/women (<b>30 meters target face 80cm 6 rings</b>)</p> <p>TEAM ELIMINATION ROUND (EXCEPT FOR BEGINNER CATEGORIES)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No team elimination round for beginner categories only</li><li>• The 8 best team from each category are eligible for the team elimination round.</li><li>• Each team need to shoot maximum 4 end, each end 6 arrow in 120 seconds.</li><li>• The first team reaches 5 point is considered as winner.</li><li>• If both teams get tie 4 point, each archer need to shoot off 1 arrow within 20 second.</li></ul>
