Tents can be put up and left at archers risk WA 720 - Ranking Round Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> Recurve 70m and Barebow 50m on a 122cm face, Compound 50m on a 6 ring 80cm face **August** Registration and Equipment Check: 8am Practice:9am (45 minutes) First rounds of Head to Heads for Team and Mixed Team (Time dependent) **Medal Ceremony for Ranking Round Head to Heads** Sunday 18th August Recurve 70m, Compound and Barebow 50m - Practice: 9am AM – Home Nations Teams- Archers to shoot as per gender/bowtype > 3 archers per each Home Nation Team > plus one combined team made up from an archer from each Home Nation PM - Mixed Home Nation Teams for each bowtype (The 2 top scoring archers in each gender, for each nation and combined team in the ranking round will make up each mixed team, this is set and archers cannot be swapped.) **Scores** Day 1 ranking round: Points for top 12 archers – 12 points for 1st, 11 for 2nd down to 1 point for 12th place Points for Team qualification ranking – 3 for 1st, 2 for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1 for 3rd Day 2 head to head Finals: Points for team and mixed team, 4 for 1st, 3 for 2nd, 2 for 3rd and 1 point for 4th The overall Home Nation Champions is the nation with the most points Awards: **Qualification Medals for:** Individual medals for: Recurve Men and Women Recurve Mens and Womens Team Compound Men and Women Compound Mens and WomensTeam Barebow Men and Women Barebow Mens and Womens Team Mixed Team Home Nation Cup Trophy and Gold Medals: Overall Home Nation Winner Disabled, Toilets, Refreshments, TBC **Facilities:** Archery GB regulation 307 will apply.
