All scores must be witnessed by another archer/scorer
 Phone apps maybe used to record and submit results
 Score sheets must be submitted by 19:00 on the last day of the month, no exceptions

Complete rounds must be shot in one continuous session This ensures the integrity of the competition by accurately reflecting each archer's endurance and concentration over a full round

Based on feedback from previous years, this year's tournament will follow a straight points format This means that each round will contribute to an archer's cumulative score, promoting consistency and sustained performance

To accommodate for holidays, sickness, and other commitments, only the highest four (4) scores out of the possible five rounds will be used to determine each archer's total score This structure provides flexibility while ensuring that all participants have a fair chance to compete for top honours

This event offers archers a chance to compete in a structured and supportive environment over the winter months

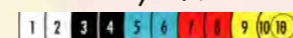

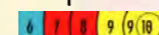
Tournament can be shot on any club day of the month

Archers will shoot on either the ten ring single-spot face, or the five ring three-spot face, small inner inner 10 for compound archers Archers will shoot sixty (60) arrows from twenty yards
