

# Winter Portsmouth 2024/25 Tournament



**Date:** Tournament runs October 2024 to February 2025 inclusive.  
One round per month, (total 5 rounds). Closing date for entries 17<sup>th</sup> September 2024  
No refunds after the Closing Date, late entries, will be subject to space and tournament organiser's discretion

**Time:** Any time archers are able to shoot during the club day normal shooting

**Round:** Portsmouth Round, (five dozen arrows)  
Portsmouth: 20 Yards, Senior age groups,  
(Men and Women: 50+; Over 21; Under 21;)

**Bow Styles:** AFB, Asiatic, Barebow, Compound, Longbow, Recurve, Traditional Recurve  
(AGB bowstyle definitions)

**Format:** Individual tournament: Based on feedback from previous years, this year's tournament will follow a straight points format. This means that each round will contribute to an archer's cumulative score, to accommodate for holidays, sickness, and other commitments, only the highest four (4) scores out of the possible five rounds will be used to determine each archer's total score.  
Ties will be determined by most number of 10's and then hits  
  
Team tournament: If there are the entries to support club teams a team tournament will also be run

**Submitting Score Sheets:** Every month archers will be sent a score sheet via email that will contain a QR Code for the lanseo ScorekeeperNG App (available for Android & iPhone).  
The preferred method of scoring is to use the app to submit your scores live as you shoot the round.

ALTERNATIVELY, score sheets may be emailed to the TO via other device based scoring apps, or finally via sending an email copy of your score sheet.  
*All score sheets must be received by 19:00 on the last day of the month, NO exceptions.*

**Rules:** Archery GB Rules of Shooting, Rule 307, will NOT apply.

**Venue:** Canford Magna Bowmen, Cobhams Sports & Social Club  
At your club, shop or private range with insurance, entrants, are solely responsible for the safety at the location used for this competition

**Shooting Procedure:** Ends of six arrows or ends of three arrows will be shot in four minutes, following one end of sighters.
