We are excited to announce that our Winter Frostbite tournament for this year will adopt a straight points format, providing a competitive yet flexible structure for all participating archers

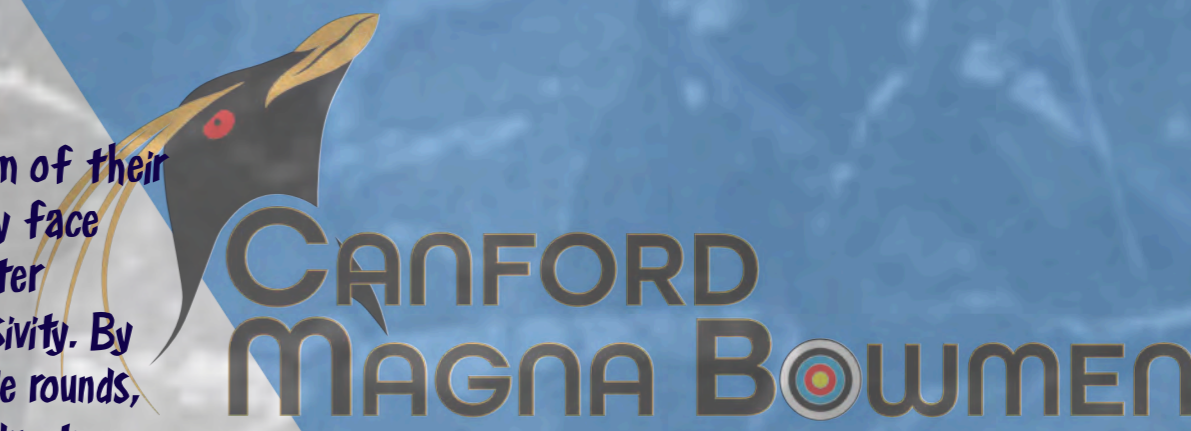
The tournament will span over five rounds, with one round held each month. This schedule is designed to accommodate and, ensuring everyone has ample opportunity to participate and compete.

The tournament will operate on a cumulative points system. Each archer's final score for the tournament will be the sum of their best four (4) round scores. Understanding that archers may face various commitments and weather challenges during the winter months, we have structured the tournament to ensure inclusivity. By considering only the best four scores out of the five possible rounds, we aim to accommodate those who may be unable to shoot due to personal reasons, travel, or inclement weather

We are excited to announce our Annual Winter Frostbite tournament. The tournament will span over five rounds, with one round held each month from October 2024 to February 2025.

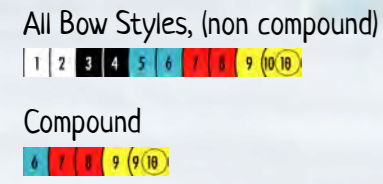
This schedule is designed to accommodate the varying states of the Winter weather, ensuring everyone has ample opportunity to participate and compete.
