

Ayr Open WA18 (UKRS) (Saturday 9th November 2024)

Date & Timings	 Morning session: Hall and registration open at 8.30am. Inspection from 9am followed by assembly at 9.15am. Two ends of practice and shooting will commence at 9.30am. Afternoon session: Registration from 12 noon (we would ask that archers for the afternoon session do not enter the hall until the morning session is finished). Inspection from 12.30pm followed by assembly at 12.45pm. Two ends of practice and shooting will commence at 1pm. All times are subject to change but will be no earlier than stated times. Presentations will not commence until the afternoon results have been collated.

Entry and Fee	Only the first round you shoot on the day will qualify for awards (If you shoot both sessions, only the morning session will be used for awards). Entries will be on a first come first served basis. Round	WA18 5 dozen arrows shot at 18m in 3 arrow ends. Recurve, barebow, longbow (all age groups): 40cm 10 zone target face - 4 targets per boss Compound (all age groups): 40cm triple spot 5 zone face - 4 targets per boss
Age Groups/ Categories	Men/ Women/ Senior, 50+, U21, U16 for each bowstyle. An archer may compete in a junior age group where the tournament takes place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category. (e.g., if they turned 15 in a year, they can compete in an U16 category, but they cannot turn 16 in the year) An archer may compete in the 50+ division when the competition takes place in the year of their 50th Birthday and thereafter.

ArcheryGB Cards	You must show your AGB card at registration. Archers who cannot show a card or receipt will not be permitted to shoot.
Dress Regulations	Archery GB dress regulations apply. Please comply with the dress code until after the presentations.

Ayr Archery Club Open Awards	Awards shall be given according to entries received subject to a minimum of:1-2 entries= Gold only3-4 entries= Gold & Silver5+= Gold, Silver & Bronze
Robin Badges	There will be an opportunity to buy a 'Robin Pinbadge'. The colour of the robin's breast will depend on your score on the day. Pin badges are £3 each.
Drug Testing	Archers may, at any time, be liable for drug testing and if competitors are approached to give samples they must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug test to be permitted if sought.
Photography	Provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, must register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. Authorised photos taken on the day may be used by Ayr Archery Club and Scottish Archery to promote the sport. If you do not wish to be photographed please inform the Tournament Secretary.
