Gentlemen: 50+, Senior, Under 21, Under 18, Under 16, Under 15, Under 14, Under 12

**Bow Styles:** American Flatbow, Asiatic, Barebow, Compound, Longbow, Recurve, Traditional Recurve

**Format:** Bray II - Compound: Senior archers & Juniors U21, U18 & U16, will shoot on an individual vertical 3-spot 60cm face. All AFB, Asiatic, Barebow, Longbow, Recurve & junior compound archers U15, U14 & U12, will shoot on a 60cm full face

**Shooting Procedure:** Two details, (AGB Method 2). **Ends of 3 arrows**

**Registration:** 09:00

**Equipment Inspection:** 09:15

**Assembly:** 09:30, followed by 1 end of sighters

**Rules:** ArcheryGB [Rules of Shooting](#) and ArcheryGB dress regulations, Rule 307 **WILL** apply

**Drug Testing:** Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply.  
Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.  
Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached
