



Venue and location: Approaching the roundabout in the centre of Ampthill, take the B530 Woburn Street towards Ampthill Great Park. Flitwick road towards Ampthill town centre. Continue along Woburn Street, pass Alameda road on your left, Russel Court on your right and you will see on your left "The Ampthill Register Office", then the "Ampthill Cadet Centre (Army & ATC)". The next building will be the "Parkside Community centre". Turn into the entrance and continuing past the main building to the back where you will find the Alameda Middle school Sports hall. X marks the spot. Please proceed to the entrance to the Sports hall.
