Archery GB / WA:

All entrants must be members of Archery GB (GNAS) or a WA associated organisation. Archers **WILL** be asked to show current membership cards before registration. If this is not provided you will not be able to shoot the competition.

Dress:

Archery GB dress regulation (Rule 307) or Club colours.

Photography:

Any person wishing to take photographs **MUST** complete a photography registration form on the day of the competition.

Drug testing:

Record status shoots are liable to drug testing, competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result for an illegal substance.

Parents/guardians of junior archers must sign the consent form to signify consent to their child being drug tested if approached.

Juniors:

Junior entrants will shoot as adults as this is a Senior tournament. All juniors under the age of 18 must be supervised.

Club Teams:

Clubs are encouraged to compete for the Club Championship Trophy. Teams will consist of four archers, representing at least three of the four bow styles (LB/BB/RC/CUL), and must include at least one archer of each sex. Clubs may enter more than one team (e.g. club A/B/C). Details of Team members must be sent to the Tournament Organisers by Friday 10th January 2025.

GDPR:

When you enter competitions, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, and other competitors. For example, target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
