- Archers will shoot 36 scoring arrows, from 30m, at a single spot 80cm face, twice
- All target bosses for compound and recurve archers will be “Danage” foam, seated on open “H frames”, and straw bosses for longbow archers
- Compound archers will shoot at an individual 3-spot face
- There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in two details
- Target list/results will be made available on the LAA website
- Strictly No Refunds
- Archers with a disability should inform the Tournament Organiser at the time of entry should they wish to stay on the shooting line
