Archers may enter rounds above their age group if desired and will be eligible for awards. Archers may also enter rounds below their age group but will not be eligible for awards.

Record Status Shoots are liable for Drug testing. Any competitors approached to give samples MUST comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached.
Entrants must declare their Archery GB membership number when entering and membership cards must be shown when registering on the day. Failure to do so will result in you not being allowed to shoot.
In line with the recommendation in the AGB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event are to register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival. Unauthorised photography is not permitted. Photos and videos taken at this event may be used by Cleve Archers across its communication channels to promote the sport. For record status events there are dress regulations in place that have to be followed by all competitors. These are set out in the Archery GB Rules of Shooting. Any archer not complying with these regulations may not be permitted to shoot.

When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared

Juniors Date of Birth is only used for selecting / checking correct round shot. Contact information such as email, addresses & phone numbers will not be published and only available to the Tournament Organiser to enable them to contact the archer if required to do so.
