Bad Weather Procedure

Given the current weather forecast and the variability of reports of lightning and other weather factors the following procedure, or parts thereof, **may** be called into play:

In the event of prospective or actual bad weather, in respect of a major championships / tour stage:

1. If it is anticipated and more than 75% certainty of bad weather the COJ, in discussion with Organiser of the event, and the Archery GB representative(s) (for National Tour stages) then the qualification round **may** be reduced to a full 36 Arrows.

a. If a qualification round is abandoned then the positions of the qualification are based on the last full round completed.

2. If the qualification round is complete but the event is abandoned in the Matchplay phases, then:

a. Results are issued on the basis of the last full round shot for a division (i.e. if the CM have completed a 1/32 but the RM are 1/2 way through their 1/32 round, the CM positions are issued based on their head to head, where as the RM would be issued on the Ranking Round)

b. For the purpose of final ranking, the archers are ordered in the order of highest ranked to lowest ranked that remain in the tournament i.e.

i. You are left with 1,2,5,7,8,9,10: this becomes 1,2,3,4,5,6,7 etc. All positions would receive an absolute rank basis rather than grouped.

ii. All those who fall between 9-16 would receive 9th place points, 17 to 32 would get 17th place points and 33 to 64 would be given 33rd place points.

In cases such as the above, the points awarded will be approved before being added to the rankings. Therefore the rankings may not be published until up to 72 hours following the shoot.
