

2025 WAP PAC-AGDP TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

(as of 16 July 2025)

- 1. This is a Non-Smoking Event. No smoking or vaping at the Practice and Official Competition Areas.
- 2. World Archery has a zero tolerance policy on Alcohol. Alcohol Consumption is not allowed for athletes, coaches, team officials and event officials/staff during competition. Disqualification or harsher penalties can be applied by WAP.
- 3. Please wear your Tournament Identification Card (ID) at all times. NO ID, NO ENTRY.
- 4. Equipment Inspection
 - a. To be performed by the Judges during Official Practice;
 - b. Teams/Clubs will be called in alphabetical order;
 - c. Spare equipment must be brought also for inspection;
- 5. Entry to the Field of Play (FOP) will be restricted to Archers and Coaches who are scheduled to shoot in that Session only;
- 6. The ratio of Coaches on the line per Club is 50% of the Club's total number of archers. During Eliminations/Olympic Rounds, the allowed ratio shall be 1 Coach:1 Archer on the line. Others must remain behind the Equipment Line and under the tents.
- 7. During the QR and Individual OR/Eliminations, Coaches and their Scopes are allowed only until the Equipment Line;
- 8. During Team Events, Coaches are allowed until the Waiting Line. Each Team, including the Coach, is allowed one (1) Scope only. Binoculars allowed at all times.
- 9. Archers are allowed to have Scopes on the shooting line provided:
 - a. There is ample space to accommodate the scope without infringing on other archer's space;
 - b. The archer must be willing to share the scope with butt mates; If an archer is not willing to share the scope, then scope must be positioned at least 1 meter behind the shooting line, provided it does not infringe on another archer's shooting space;
 - c. If there is not enough space on the line, the scope can be place 1 meter behind the shooting line, provided it does not infringe on other archer's shooting space;
 - d. The scope lens must be no higher than the archers armpit;
- 10. During the OR/Eliminations/Medal Matches The Coach and the Archer must be in the same Club Uniform.
- 11. Please leave the FOP after your schedule as we will not allow entry of the next batch of archers if there are people inside the FOP.
- 12. ANNOUNCEMENTS The WAP Organizing Group/DOS shall Announce/Call names of archers who are up for Matches ONE TIME only. It is not the responsibility of WAP to look for/chase archers who are not present at their Matches when they are scheduled. Please check your Schedules either via the DOS or through lanseo.

- 13. Archers are requested to walk in double time during scoring and retrieving arrows as our time is quite limited.
- 14. Clubs are requested to bring at least 3 smart devices with installed Ianseo Scorekeeper NG as scoring device, no need to have SIM/mobile data as we will use WIFI.
- 15. Always counter-check lanseo scoring vs. Paper Scorecard scoring.
- 16. Scoring will be done simultaneous, Ianseo and Paper Scorecard. However, the paper scorecard has scoring priority.
- 17. Equipment Failure/Medical Issues In the event equipment failure or a medical issue, during the QR only, verified by a Judge or Medical Personnel, Fifteen (15) Minutes shall be allowed for equipment failure or the treatment of medical problems. However, the maximum time or number of ends for make-up arrows to be shot is 15 minutes (following regular order of shooting and timing), or two (2) ends of six (6) arrows outdoors, whichever happens first. The archer shall make up the appropriate number of arrows at the earliest opportunity under the supervision of a Judge.
- 18. WAP Judges' decisions are all FINAL and UNAPPEALABLE.
- 19. Spectators cannot enter the FOP. They are limited to the area outside the barriers.
- 20. Aside from the Tents for Rent, there will be no tents or chairs provided for spectators.
