2.2 Competition programme

The current version of the schedule, now of writing, the team managers' booklet is V 0.1 (26 September 2025 11:00UTC). Please frequently refer to the World Archery Europe website for the latest updates on the schedule, as changes may occur during the week.

2.3 Practice

- 2.3.1 Training range is available on Sep 28, 15:00-18:00 next to the base camp.
- 2.3.2 Official practice for all categories will take place next to the base camp from 9:00 to 11:30 and 14:00 to 16:30 on Sep 29.
- 2.3.3 Group1 morning: AUT, CRO, CYP, CZE, DEN, ESP, FIN, FRA, GBR, GER, HUN, IRL Group 2 afternoon: ISR, ITA, LAT, NOR, ROU, AIN, SLO, SMR, SRB, SUI, SVK, SWE
- 2.3.4 Warm up during all days of the competition will be organized on training range according to the schedule published.

2.4 Equipment inspection

The equipment inspection will be done during official practice.

The equipment inspection will not be limited to only the official practice; judges can, at any time during the competition, require inspection of an athlete's equipment.







If the equipment is found to be not compliant with World Archery rules, the athlete will need to fix the issue immediately or will be removed from the competition.

- 2.4.1 All teams are to wear their team uniform with their name and have their valid accreditation during official practice.
- 2.4.1.1 While athletes are allowed to wear jeans for qualification, they must have the full uniform for inspection and for all rounds after qualification.
- 2.4.1.2 None of the athletes' clothing, equipment or accessories may have any camouflage pattern on any part
- 2.4.2 Spare equipment must also be brought for inspection.
- 2.4.3 Team managers are to check the details of their athletes, such as name and date of birth, beforehand.
- 2.4.4 Inform the Judge if details are not correct and the Judge will inform Results Team. Instructions to use the tablet scoring system will be provided if requested.

Athlete (back) Numbers

Athlete numbers will be issued on the day of the qualification round (with the score cards) when groups are called. Athlete numbers must be worn on the quiver or thigh, facing the waiting line while shooting.

The Environment

Team managers, please instruct your team members to use the litter bins located on the competition, practice ranges and common areas at all times.

Water

All participants will receive water bottles as souvenirs. They can fill their bottles with the water from the tank. There will also be a dispenser for water on the field, and two on each qualification course. There will be no cups available.

Non-Smoking

This is a non-smoking event.

Smoking is forbidden inside public buildings and all competition and training areas. This also includes electronic cigarettes, refer to book 4, Art.26.4.

2.5 Rounds

There are 3 courses prepared for two qualification rounds, a practice field, courses for the team event, for the mixed team event, for individual eliminations and a final field all around the central area.

2.6 Appeal procedure

- 2.6.1 An Appeal form is attached to this document.
- 2.6.2 In case of an intent to appeal or an actual appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form must be considered.
- 2.6.3 Appeal forms should be given to the Chairman of the Judge or to his deputy.
- 2.6.4 A fee of 50 EUR must be paid to the CJ for the appeal to be valid.
- 2.6.5 If the appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. In the case of the appeal being rejected, the fee will not be returned.







4. RESULTS

4.1 Timing control system

World Archery timing equipment will be used for timing and scoreboards during finals.

4.2 Results system

- Qualification Round scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete record, on the official paper-based score sheet, the scores of all other athletes on that target. At the same time, another athlete, on that same target, will enter all the scores of the athletes on that target into the scoring tablet.
- Scorecards MUST be signed by both the athlete and the scorer and have all the totals mathematically correct. Any score cards not signed or the score total is missing will result in disqualification.
- Elimination Round scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete/team records the arrow values of both athletes/teams on the paper score sheet. While at the same time, the other athlete/team inputs the arrow values into the scoring tablet. Both athletes/teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning back to the shooting line.

Δnd

- At the end of the match, the scorecard must be fully completed and signed by the athletes (or agent/judge in the case of finals) involved in the match.
- Scoring tablets will be used during the Qualification and Elimination Rounds, but not in the Finals. Ardingo Scarzella is responsible for the results of the event.
- IMPORTANT NOTE: There will be internet access in the official hotels and the venues. Because of this we will not distribute any printed results and information.







5. REMINDER ON RULES

5.1 Dress regulations

- Athletes shall wear shirts with name and country at all times.
- Sport shoes or walking boots shall be worn by all athletes and officials, these may be different styles but shall cover
 the entire foot.
- Athletes may wear trousers of their choice for the Qualification round.
- Athletes shall wear full Team uniform, which shall not include denim, for Team Rounds and Medal Matches.
- Clothing and equipment shall not be camouflage. No oversize or baggy type trousers are allowed.
- Team officials shall have their country on their shirt or jacket, and shall be the same colour, so that they are easily recognisable as part of the team.

5.2 Rules update

There have been some major changes to the Equipment Rules.

- Barebow Rules to allow dampeners (Book 4 22.3.6.1)
- Number of arrows: In an individual, two arrows per target will be shot in all rounds.

In teams four arrows shall be shot at each target in all rounds, one arrow by each team member.

5.3 Accreditation cards rules

Rule Book 2 – 3.8 Accreditation

- 3.8.1.1. Proof of accreditation shall always be carried in the competition area and shall be shown upon request of appropriate officials.
- 3.8.1.2. Only holders of appropriate accreditation shall be allowed onto the relevant parts of the competition area.

Accreditation card:

Athletes and team officials, registered in WAREOS, will be issued a World Archery Europe accreditation on lanyard. Please ensure all details are correctly entered in WAREOS.

Accreditation will consist of, a photograph, full name, role, category/bow discipline, country of representation, individual World Archery ID code and access privileges.

Only athletes scheduled to compete at certain stages of the event are permitted on the Field of Play, together with one coach/official.

Photographs

Will be taken on venue the day prior to official practice. For athlete who do not already have one.

For a valid photograph, persons are to smile and wear their official Member Association team uniform. No hats or sunglasses can be worn.

Photos are used for both event accreditation and website biographies.

Athletes and team official profile photographs expire after 24 months. Athletes and team officials whose photographs have expired will be contacted to schedule a time during the week to retake the picture, in order to avoid affluence and gathering at accreditation booth.

Any athlete or official that desires to update their photograph in the system can go to the accreditation area to do so during the competition week.







Lost/Damage/Replacement costs:

For those persons who unfortunately forget to bring, damage or lose their accreditation, can purchase another accreditation from the accreditation area at the event for the cost of 50 EUR.

6. LOGISTICS

6.1 Transportation

Daily transportation information and schedules will be placed online, at the competition field and notice boards at all the official event hotels.

6.2 Meals during the event

Breakfast and dinner will be offered at all official hotels. Drinking water will be available free of charge.

Lunch will be served in the base camp. Daily lunch schedule and menu will be posted on site and online on https://euro3dserbia.com/ Water will be available from water dispensers. Don't forget to bring your bottle. Cups will not be available.

For the qualification days (30.09. and 01.10.), sack lunches will be provided at the call area.

If there are any specific food requests or requirements, please inform as soon as possible LOC.

6.3 Internet Access and additional hotel charges

Internet access will be free of charge in the rooms and lobby of official hotels, there will also be free internet access on venue. All other hotel expenses including laundry and minibar, etc will be covered by the participants themselves.

6.4 Medical related issues

Basic medical supplies will be available at archery venues.

7. PROTOCOL, CEREMONIES, CLEAN SPORT

7.1 Opening ceremony

There will be opening ceremony on 29 Sep starting at 17:00 at the hotel Crni Vrh. Transport from the hotel Pepa, the hotel Heba and the venue will be provided.

7.2 Medal ceremonies

All athletes involved in the ceremonies are requested to go to the gathering point by the athletes' entrance to the main FoP., Equipment can be stored in the staging area until the end of the corresponding victory ceremony.

7.3 Mixed zone and press conferences

Interviews will take place in front of the stage immediately after the gold medal match.

7.4 Closing ceremony and party

Immediately after finals a short closing ceremony will be held.

Dinner will be served for all participants in hotels and after dinner there will be a party organized (price for party is 15€, need to be paid during registration on 28 Sep). Transport will be organized from hotels Pepa and Heba.

7.5 Clean sport

Anti-doping

Anti-Doping control will follow World Archery rules.

Athletes should bring their passports and/or accreditation cards to the anti-doping control station if selected for a test.

Alcohol test

Athletes and officials should also be available for random alcohol testing during the competition, following World Archery rules.
